FATAL TRAFFIC COLLISION

RIVERSIDE, CA – On Friday, October 28, 2016, at approximately 9:30 AM, Riverside Police and Fire responded to a report of an auto vs. motorcycle collision on Indiana Ave west of Washington St. in the City of Riverside. Upon arrival, Officers determined an adult female, driving a late model Toyota Rav4, was exiting a private property parking lot on the north side of Indiana Ave. Intending on making a left turn onto eastbound Indiana. The driver of the Toyota did not yield to a motorcycle which was traveling west on Indiana Ave in the lane closest to the right curb. The motorcycle, a newer Yamaha R3 being driven by a 35 year old Riverside resident collided broadside with the Toyota. The motorcycle rider, the Toyota driver and an adult passenger inside the Toyota were all transported to Riverside Community Hospital. Both occupants of the Toyota sustained non-life-threatening injuries. The motorcyclist was pronounced deceased while at the hospital.

Officers from the Riverside Police Department M.A.I.T. were called to the scene and are investigating. The name of the decedent will be released by the Riverside County Coroner's Office pending their investigation and notification of next of kin.
