DECEASED SUBJECT FOUND AT FAIRMOUNT PARK

RIVERSIDE, CA – On Saturday, January 14, 2017, at about 10:17 a.m., the Riverside Police Department's Communications Center received a call of a subject floating in the water at Fairmount Park, located at 2601 Fairmount Boulevard in the city of Riverside.

Members of the Riverside Police and Fire departments responded and found a subject floating face down in the smaller run off pond along the north shore of Lake Evans inside the park. Fire personnel entered the lake, retrieved the body and pronounced the subject deceased.

A detective from the Robbery-Homicide Unit responded and was assisted by the Riverside County Sheriff-Coroner's Office. The preliminary investigation was unable to determine a cause of death and there were no obvious signs of foul play present. The body was fully clothed and appears to be of a white male adult. At this time, the identity and age of the subject has not been determined and any further details are pending the Coroner's investigation.
