ARREST MADE IN ASSAULT WITH A DEADLY WEAPON INVESTIGATION

RIVERSIDE, CA – On Tuesday, February 28, 2017, at about 7:00 p.m., Riverside Police Officers responded to Parkview Hospital in Riverside regarding a male adult being treated for possible stab wounds. The victim was listed in stable condition but was uncooperative with officers as to how he was injured.

Detectives responded to assist in the investigation and were able to develop suspect information and where the incident occurred. A search warrant was obtained and served by detectives and members of the METRO Team (SWAT) in the 10000 block of Overton Drive, in the Arlanza neighborhood. Several people were detained at the residence, including the possible suspect. During the search, a handgun, holster, and ammunition were recovered.

Preliminary investigation determined a dispute occurred between the victim and suspect at this location. The suspect pointed a firearm at the victim, threatened to shoot him then a physical fight ensued. The victim sustained a laceration during the physical altercation. The handgun recovered is believed to be the one used by the suspect.



Israel Estrada, 23-years-old of Riverside, was arrested and later booked into the Robert Presley Detention Center for assault with a deadly weapon, criminal threats, and weapons violations.
