HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION

RIVERSIDE, CA – On April 27, 2017, at approximately 12:23 am, Riverside Police Officers responded to the 3300 block of Lime St reference multiple gun shots being heard. The Riverside Police Department’s Communication Center received several calls from residents in the immediate area. Once patrol officers arrived, they located an adult male who was suffering from what appeared to be a fatal gunshot wound. Members of the Riverside Fire Department, along with Emergency Medical Technicians, were unable to resuscitate the man due to his injuries.

Detectives from the Robbery – Homicide Unit, Gang Intelligence Unit and Evidence Technicians from the Forensic Unit responded to investigate. Detectives are being assisted by the Riverside County District Attorney’s Office and the Riverside Sheriff – Coroner. The victim’s identity is pending a Coroner’s investigation.
