RIVERSIDE POLICE DEPARTMENT NOW RECRUITING FOR TEEN ACADEMY

RIVERSIDE, CA – The Riverside Police Department is accepting applications for its Teen Academy, which runs from June 22, 2017 through August 10, 2017. Recruitment is now open through May 19, 2017, or until the class is full.

This course is designed to give teens an overview of the department's operational methods. It will provide insight as to how police personnel perform their duties. Most sessions will be held in the Riverside Police Department's Community Room on Thursday evenings from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., located at 10540 Magnolia Avenue, Suite B.

Class size is limited and applications will only be accepted online through the RPD website. Applicants must live or attend school in the City of Riverside, and pass an informal background check. All sessions are in a classroom setting and may require someone to be able to lift up to 15 lbs. and stand for up to three hours.
