The City of Riverside Board of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing to discuss modifications to its Water and Electric Rules and Rates (but is not proposing increases to its rates), as follows:

1. To adjust the monthly demand levels as specified in Electric Schedule A “General Service” and Electric Schedule TOU “Large General and Industrial Service” to any two of the preceding 12 months in order to meet the criteria of the rate.
2. To adjust the application of the seasons for residential customers with space heating engineered to heat the entire family accommodation under Electric Schedule D “Domestic Service” to be consistent throughout the rate schedule.
3. To include and update definitions in Electric and Water Rule 1 for business, general service, planned residential development, residential service, single-family dwelling unit, and multi-family dwelling units.
4. To clarify the applicability sections of Electric Schedule D “Domestic Service”, Water Schedule WA-1 “Residential Metered Service”, and Water Schedule WA-6 “General Metered Service”.
5. To clarify the responsibilities for fire protection services with below ground or above ground detector assemblies under Water Schedule WA-5 “Fire Protection Services and Fire Hydrants”.
6. To amend Electric and Water Rule 6 “Meter Investigations and Adjustments of Bills” to include clarification for the rate application of customers establishing service at an existing location and limit the credit for over-collection due to fast meters to one year.
7. To amend Electric and Water Rule 7 “Discontinuance and Restoration of Electric/Water Service” to address mandated notification requirements.
8. To adjust Electric and Water Rule 12 so to prevent sub-metered customers from being inappropriately charged for electric or water service.

9. To address non-substantive changes to certain rules or rate tariffs to clarify the intent and to address routine administrative updates.

Customers wishing to comment on the proposed actions should attend this meeting, or forward written comments to the Public Utilities General Manager at 3901 Orange Street, Riverside, CA 92501, prior to the hearing.
