**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**  
**Riverside Basin Groundwater Management Plan**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held before the City of Riverside Board of Public Utilities on Friday, November 2, 2012, at 8:30 a.m. in the Riverside Public Utilities Customer Service Plaza at 3460 Orange Street (Orange Street and 5<sup>th</sup> Street), Riverside, California to receive comments on the Riverside Basin Groundwater Management Plan. The California Legislature enacted Assembly Bill 3030 to provide local public agencies increased management authority over their groundwater resources and subsequently enacted Senate Bill 1938 to encourage local public agencies to adopt groundwater management plans in order to increase their eligibility for grant funds for groundwater related projects (Water Code section 10750). The adoption of a groundwater management plan is encouraged, but not required.
