Board Update Meeting Summary | Friday July 10, 2015

Board of Public Utilities approves Consent Calendar Items without comment as listed below:

- Approval was given for \$105,000 work order to relocate overhead electrical facilities at Van Buren Boulevard and Colorado Street for renovation project at Wal Mart.
- Approved capital expenditure of \$135,000 for a work order to relocate a water main on Myers Street.
- Approval was given for a work order of \$52,492 for construction to connect a new housing development (tract of 32) to water service located at La Sierra and Orchard View Lane.
- Approved Professional Consultant Services contract of \$125,000 for electric cost of service analysis and rate design project with Leidos Engineering, LLC., of Riverside.
- Received and filed Riverside Box Art Pilot Project, for GRCC Leadership Class of 2015 to beautify pad-mounted utility structures downtown.

Board approves construction of water main relocation at Tyler and Bonita

Approval was given for \$176,000 work order for the water main to be relocated to assist the Public Works Department with a street improvement in the area.

Board recommended that the City Council approve proposed water productions, conveyance and reciprocal sales agreement with the Regents of the University of California

Deputy General Manager Kevin Milligan gave a presentation that explained UCR's unique position as an RPU customer. UCR has water rights and was part of the lawsuit in 1969 that adjudicated RPU's water rights at the Bunker Hill Basin and other Riverside Groundwater Basins. He explained how their water is delivered to them through our system. The board voted to approve the 10 year contract and authorize the City Manager to execute new agreements. The last agreement was from 1993, and staff has been negotiating new one for the past 18 months. This agreement would go into effect from June 1, 2015.

All other items were deferred to the next meeting. A board member had to leave in the middle of the meeting which caused a lack of quorum.
