The Utilities Water Systems Operations Manager is a key position within the Utility and reports directly to the Assistant Public Utilities Director/Water. This position performs highly complex administrative support not only to the Assistant Director, but also the Public Utility General Manager and the Board of Public Utilities.

The Utilities Water Systems Operations Manager will supervise, coordinate and review all water system operations activities for a Domestic Water and Irrigation system with over 60,000 domestic service connections. The Water Division is currently undertaking major capital improvement

projects involving bringing new reservoirs and treatment plants on-line, and the replacement of pipelines, meters and booster pumps. The City of Riverside's water system includes more than 900 miles of pipeline, and over 16 reservoirs with a combined capacity of 100 million gallons. A majority of our water is from groundwater, with a fraction of our supply purchased from the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California.

The ideal candidate will have the hands-on experience in the design, operation and maintenance of GAC and Ion-exchange treatment facilities; have the ability to determine the scope of projects, review plans and specifications for major projects; make operational decisions on water production, basin management and coordinate through subordinate supervisors the construction, maintenance repair of operational facilities; and establish technical criteria and standards.

Educational Requirements

Education

Possession of or the ability to obtain within one year, a valid Water Treatment Operator's Certificate Grade 4 and Water Distribution Operator's Certificate Grade 5, issued by the California Department of Health Services is

required. Registration in California as a Professional Engineer is desirable. An advanced degree in Engineering and/or Business Management is highly desirable.

Experience

This position requires any combination equivalent to experience and education that could likely provide the required knowledge and abilities in qualifying. A typical way to obtain the knowledge and abilities would be three years supervisory/management experience in the construction and/or maintenance and repair of water systems or the operation, production, and maintenance of water pumping, treatment and storage facilities and equipment.

Necessary Special Requirement

Possession of or ability to obtain an appropriate, valid California motor vehicle operator's license.
