The City of Riverside Board of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing to discuss modifications to its Water and Electric Rules and Rates (but is not proposing increases to its rates), as follows:

1. To eliminate section J. "Revenue Insufficient to Warrant Expense" of Electric Rule 11, require deposits for the costs of design of utility facilities and make other non-substantive changes to Electric Rule 11.
2. To adjust Electric Rule 6 and Water Rule 6 to limit overcharges to be recomputed and credited to any account for a period of one year prior to the discovery of an error, or the date the bill was questioned, whichever occurs earlier.
3. To adjust the application of Electric Rate PA "Power – Agricultural and Pumping" to the pumping of water for general agricultural uses only.
4. To amend the Electric and Water Rules and Rate schedules to address routine administrative updates and other non-substantive changes.

Customers wishing to comment on the proposed actions should attend this meeting, or forward written comments to the Public Utilities General Manager at 3901 Orange Street, Riverside, CA 92501, prior to the hearing.
