
GENERAL NOTES:

- 1. No person shall perform any construction activity or install any objects within the public rights -of-way or easements of the City of Riverside without a valid Construction Permit or, a Street Opening Permit or an Encroachment Permit issued by the City's Public Works Department.
- 2. It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to clear the right of way in accordance with the provisions of law as it affects each utility including irrigation lines and appurtenances and at no cost to the City.
- 3. Construction shall be in accordance with the City of Riverside Department of Public Works, Standard Drawings, its Supplemental Notes and the Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction, current edition.
- 4. The private engineer signing these plans is responsible for assuring the accuracy and acceptability of the work hereon. In the event of discrepancies arising during construction, the private engineer shall be responsible for determining an acceptable solution and revising the plans for approval by

- 6. The developer shall be responsible for preserving or re-establishing and referencing survey monuments destroyed, disturbed or buried as a result of construction shown hereon.
- 7. Any traffic control striping obliterated and/or badly worn during construction shall be restored by the contractor within five days after notification from
- 8. Final striping for traffic control and/or pavement marking to be the responsibility of the developer.
- 9. The contractor shall call in a location request to Underground Service Alert (USA), Phone # 1-800-227-2600, two working days before digging. No construction permit will be issued by the Public Works Department involving excavation for underground facilities unless the applicant has been provided an inquiry identification number by U.S.A.
- 10. The contractor shall coordinate trenching for cable television with other trenching within the subdivision.
- 11. Contractor shall verify existing sewer elevation prior to construction.
- 12. No finished floor elevation shall be less than 6" above the upper manhole rim elevation of the sewer line segment being connected to, without having a proper backwater valve installed in the lateral.
- 13. A plug shall be installed and will remain in place where the new sewer connects with the existing sewer until the new sewer is accepted by the City.
- 14. The sewer contractor shall adjust manholes to final grade after paving is completed.
- 15. Prior to construction the contractor shall pothole all utility crossings and connections and verify the location and elevation of all utilities affected. The engineer shall be notified of any discrepancies before construction begins.
- 16. NOTICE TO CONTRACTOR: The existence and location of any underground utility pipes or structures shown on these plans were obtained by a search of available records. To the best of our knowledge there are no existing utitities except as shown on these plans. The contractor is required to take precautionary measures to protect the utilities shown or any other utilities not of record or not shown on these plans.
