



❖ STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE ❖ (Moisture Content of Lumber)

The California Green Building Standards Code requires that the individual responsible for the construction of newly constructed low-rise residential buildings verify that the wood framing members used do not exceed 19% moisture content.

Please review the following and submit this completed form to your City of Riverside Building Inspector prior to the framing inspection.

I have verified that the moisture content of framing members within the building identified on this form does not exceed 19%. Verification has been performed as follows:

- 1) A probe-type or contact-type moisture meter was used to verify the moisture content of the lumber in the building.***
- 2) At least three random moisture readings were performed on wall and floor framing members.***
- 3) Moisture readings were taken at a point 2 feet to 4 feet from the grade stamped end of each piece to be verified.***
