1 Narrative:

On 10-31-17 at about 1112 hours, I responded to Castle View Elementary School, in reference to a school disturbance involving a parent hitting a teacher and taking another teacher hostage into a classroom.

5 **Statements / Investigative Actions:**

I responded from the Magnolia Police Station, located at 10540 Magnolia Av. I arrived on scene and was 6 on a perimeter location on the south side of the multi-purpose room (MPR). While on the perimeter I saw 7 a teacher (Mrs. Gallardo-Peredes) and a mom that volunteers in Mrs. Gallardo's class run from building A 8 towards us. I recognized the teacher and the mom and asked the teacher where the children were. Mrs. 9 10 Gallardo said the children were in the MPR. I obtained a key from one of the janitors and located numerous students inside of the MPR. I assisted in evacuating the students out of the MPR to safety. I 11 then assisted in evacuating students out of building B, building C and the portables on the upper campus 12 13 area.

After the students on the upper campus were evacuated I received information from S1's mother (Tonya 15

Kennon) that S1 drives a GMC Yukon. Tonya Kennon advised that S1 walked to the school and the GMC 16

Yukon was parked in the driveway at her home. Officer Hill and I responded to the residence, 17

. We confirmed that the blue GMC Yukon, California license plate was in the 18 driveway. A records check showed the vehicle was registered to Tonya Kennon. 19

I then responded to Castleview Park, located at 1410 Via Vista Drive, to assist families reunite with the students. While at Castleview Park I was assigned to escort groups of children to the bathroom and then 22 return them to their teachers at the park.
