Scene:

The above incident occurred at 6201 Shaker Drive (Castle View Elementary School). The school property is located on the W/S of the street, north of Century Avenue.

Narrative:

On Tuesday, October 31, 2017, at approximately 1112 hours, officers responded to 6201 Shaker Drive (Castle View Elementary School) regarding a possible [REDACTED] subject/medical aid type call at the above location.

While en-route to the above call, I heard via my police vehicle radio that a male subject (S1) had taken a subject into a class room and possibly barricaded himself and the subject in the class room.

Prior to arriving on scene, I heard via my police vehicle radio that several Riverside Police Department officers had arrived or were arriving on scene and were attempting to get further information.

Prior to arriving on scene, officers and supervision that were on scene requested that arriving officers at the location start an exterior perimeter around the school.

The above incident occurred in the City and County of Riverside, State of California.

Investigative Actions:

I arrived on scene by driving E/B on Century Avenue and then N/B on Shaker Drive to the above address. As I approached the school, I observed Motor Officer G. Hirdler standing in a school parking lot located on the W/S of Shaker Drive. He was standing on the E/S of a chain link type fence that separated the school parking lot and the lower school yard area on the S/S of the school.

I entered the driveway and made contact with Motor Officer G. Hirdler. I asked him if he needed any further personnel at this location for the incident. He asked if I had any bolt cutters in my marked police vehicle so a lock and/or chain could be cut on a chain link gate that was on the chain link fence separating the school parking lot and the school yard area so access could be gained into the school property to establish a perimeter.

I removed the department issue bolt cutters that were in the trunk of my marked police vehicle (3918) and

Officer Mann and I used the bolt cutters to cut the padlock and chain off the chain link gate. The damaged lock and chain was left on the ground at the scene.

Once the chain link gate was open, I took a perimeter position on the S/W corner area of the lower school playground on the asphalt portion of the property.

I was at that location for approximately 10 minutes when school children and school staff members started to be evacuated from the school via the north/south directional driveway located on the W/S of the school property. This driveway led from the upper school playground property to the lower school playground property. I assisted and directed school children and school staff members to the S/S of the lower school playground area towards Riverside Police Department officers that were located on the S/S of the lower school playground area.

As more school students and school staff members exited the upper school playground area and onto the driveway, I moved to the top portion of the driveway near the upper school playground to assist the school children and school staff members evacuate the school safely.

Once all the school students and school staff members were off the campus, I remained at the top of the driveway by the upper school playground with Motor Officer B. Fast.

Motor Officer B. Fast and I were assigned protection duty of the Riverside Police Department Metro police vehicles and equipment during the incident.

I remained at this location until the perimeter units were cleared.

During this incident, I did not see or have any contact with any victims of this incident.
