I put on my police gear and along with Detective James Mutuku drove to the school. Upon arrival, we assisted in the evacuation of the children from several classrooms. I then assisted with a secondary search to be sure the structures were unoccupied.

I then reported back to the command post and made myself available to assist with various responsibilities throughout the day and night. After entry was made by SWAT and the victim was rescued and the suspect was transported to the hospital, I remained on scene and served as crime scene protection along with Sgt. Miera and Detective Chris Williams. We remained on scene posted up at the main entrance into the school until all Robbery Homicide and Forensics personnel completed their investigation and cleared the scene. Once they cleared we stood by as the last remaining school district supervisor locked up the offices and we all cleared.
