 Once inside classroom A-3, Officers Paes, Mowery, O'farrell, S. Lopez, Sergeant Tipre and I set up towards the center pod of the building and set up as a secondary Emergency Response Team.

Once Sergeant McCoy joined us in classroom A-3, the plan was to move into classroom A-6 and deploy a surveillance camera in attempt of gathering intelligence on S/1 and V/1. After several hours of negotiations the tactical plan was to breach the interior accordion wall and make entry into classroom A-1 and rescue the victim.

Sergeant McCoy called for a diversion towards the front of the classroom, at which time, the interior accordion wall was breached. During the breach, I noticed the interior accordion wall opened approximately a foot and got stuck. The interior Emergency Response Team attempted to force open the accordion wall but were unsuccessful. I observed Officer Paes able to partially enter the opening of the breached accordion wall. At this time, I was positioned behind Officer's Paes and Mowery and heard Officer Paes verbalize, (what I recall being) "he has the victim". I then observed Officer Paes discharge his rifle approximately five times in the direction of where I believed the suspect was at.

At this point, the interior Emergency Response Team was still unable to fully breach the accordion wall and make entry. As the victim began crawling towards us, I assisted Officer Wilder and grabbed the victim and pulled her into classroom A-6. The victim was secured by unknown personnel located inside classroom A-6. I then broadcasted "failed breached" over the radio at which time the METRO team breached the front door and made entry. Officer Paes kept \$/1 at bay by keeping him at gun point as METRO personnel approached \$/1 and placed him into custody. Medical aid was summoned for \$/1 and was shortly transported. I cleared from the classroom as the scene was secured.

During the incident I responded to the Magnolia Police Station in order to meet with the OIS investigators and got my weapons charted.
