DETAILS

On 10-31-17, at approximately 1130 hours, I responded to the address above reference a possible hostage situation with a subject at Castle View Elementary School.

I am a collateral swat team member and upon my arrival I was assigned to the turret in the ARV (Armored Reconassaince Vehicle). The ARV was positioned near the front door of the classroom which was labeled room A1. From this assignement, I was able to see the front of the structure and the windows along the face of the structure. However, due to glare I was unable to see into the interior of the structure. During the incident we were able to utilize the spot lights mounted to the top of the ARV which enabled us a partial view of the interior of the room. The view was not ideal as there was a large amount of glare which affected my view of the interior even with the use of the spotlight.

I was in this assignment for the duration of the incident and I provided updates to the command post with any movement that occurred inside the structure. Once the flash bangs were deployed I could not see into the structure from my vantage point due to the high level of smoke produced from the flash bangs deployed.

After the deployment of the flash bangs, I did hear shots being fired but I was unsure as to their origin or exactly how many. Once the incident was clear, medical aid was summoned to provide medical aid to the suspect (Luvelle Kennon) who was shot.

S/Kennon was transported via ambulance to Riverside Community Hospital where I stayed with him until emergency room personnel pronounced S/Kennon deceased at 1832 hours. S/Kennon was then moved from the trauma room to a private room where I along with Detective Acosta CUMPING HAM 8/13 and Detective Matthews stayed until the Coroner arrived to take possession of S/Kennon.
