tricted Information Belease PROHIBIT On 10-31-17, at approximately 1112 hours, I responded to Castle View Elementary School reference a possible hostage rescue incident. Dispatch advised that S1/Kennon had taken a teacher by the shirt and forced her into a classroom and would not let her leave. Dispatch updated and advised that the suspect was holding the teacher hostage and actively assaulting her in room A1. Upon my arrival I entered the 16 school and met up with the Emergency Response Team, near the cafeteria. ERT personnel advised that the suspect was possibly deploying gas inside of the classroom and had entered with two backpacks. They also advised that the suspect had barricaded the doors to the classroom with chairs and tables. Further information was broadcasted that there were no children inside the classroom.

#### **Investigative Actions:** 22

While designating roles and responsibilities for the Emergency Response Team, I was advised by 23 24 Officer Park that the Armored Rescue Vehicle (ARV) had arrived and was set up near the basketball courts to the rear of the school. Officers Soria, Wright, Pap and I left the Emergency Response Team and 25 set up with other METRO Officers at the ARV. From there, The ARV carried personnel to the front of 26 classroom A1 (last known location for S1/Kennon and victim). There Officers set up as Emergency 27 Response Team #1. I was assigned as lethal cover/point (entry). 28

At approximately 1400 hours, I was tasked with helping comprise a "throw phone" mission. I was 30 designated as the throw phone holder and tasked with placing the throw phone to the front of the classroom door (A1). At approximately 1416 hours we initiated the throw phone mission. We approached the classroom from the west facing door to the cafeteria. I placed the phone outside the sweep of the door to classroom A1. As we retreated back to cover, I secured the throw phone line around a nearby tree (approximately 15' south/east of the front door). We completed the throw phone mission at approximately 1418 hours.

After completing the throw phone mission, I met back up at the ARV and set up as Emergency Response Team #1 (lethal cover/point). After unsuccessful negotiations, a plan was made to make entry into classroom A1. I was still assigned to ERT #1 as point Officer. I was told that if the command of "failed breech" was put out over the radio, ERT #1 would approach the front door to classroom A1 and make a crisis entry. At approximately 1745 hours, the tactical plan was put into motion.

At approximately 1746 hours, Sgt. McCoy advised over the radio "failed breech" and ERT #1 made 44 our approach to the front door. While at the front door I could hear shots being fired from inside the 45

classroom. Officers Pap and Soria breeched the front door and I made entry into classroom A1 (see Officers supplemental reports for details). Upon entering the classroom I found the lights in the room to be off and a thick grey acrid smoke in the air. The classroom was in disarray with tables, desks and chairs stacked in a way to impede our entry into the classroom.

While climbing over upside down tables and chairs, Officer Paes advised me that the suspect was down in the back corner of the classroom. Due to the piles of furniture stacked in the classroom and the thick acrid smoke, I could not see Officer Paes or the suspect. I made my way (climbing over stacked chairs and tables) to the accordion wall that separated classroom A1 and A6. There I located S1/Kennon lying face down with his arms at his side, against the wall (head towards the windows of the classroom and feet towards the back wall). Next to S1/Kennon's head, I located a large pair of scissors with black handles. S1/Kennon was wearing a sweatshirt and jean pants. S1/Kennon was unresponsive and did not move.

I held lethal cover on S1/Kennon while Officer Pap placed him in handcuffs. Officer Pap rolled S1/Kennon onto his left side and conducted a search of his person. I looked at S1/Kennon's face and noticed his eyes were rolled towards the back of his head. S1/Kennon was limp and did not move while being searched. While Officer Pap searched S1/Kennon, I saw he had a wound (approximately quarter size) above his groin area, which was covered in blood. AMR paramedics were requested over the radio. Tactical Emergency medical Paramedic Vu entered the classroom and began to administer medical aid to S1/Kennon. Riverside Fire Department personnel and AMR Paramedic Cardenas entered the classroom and began to assist Paramedic Vu with triaging S1/Kennon. S1/Kennon was eventually loaded onto a gurney and evacuated to a waiting ambulance outside of the classroom.

I exited the classroom and was relieved from the scene. I responded to the Magnolia Police Station for further investigation. Concluding the investigation I was released from the Magnolia Station. NFI.
