As a member of the window port team, when prompted we were tasked with breaking and clearing two of the front window panes (far right side). After breaking and clearing the windows, we were to provide observation/lethal cover into the classroom as entry was made by the primary entry team. My specific assignment on the window port team, was to provide cover with the ballistic shield on the windows, while Officer Moulton broke open cleared the windows. (see Officer Moulton's report for further) In the event the breach failed from the primary point of entry, a secondary breach was to take place by a secondary entry team. As this secondary breach took place, I was to sight deploy a light and sound diversionary device in the room to provide a diversion/distraction for the entry team.

While at our staging location, the corner of classroom A1 and A6, we were advised over the radio that the entry was set and to start our course of action. As we approached, I provided cover for Officer Moulton as he broke and cleared the windows. While holding our location, I heard gunshots come from within the classroom. I was unable to see where the gunshots were coming from. As this was occurring, I heard "failed breach" broadcast over the radio. At this time, I laid my shield against the wall and sight deployed my light and sound diversionary device into an open area in the middle of the classroom. After doing this, the secondary entry team was able to make entry and made their way to the suspect. Upon reaching the suspect, he was placed into handcuffs and taken into custody.

After the location was cleared, medical aid was summoned into the room and tended to the suspect's injuries. I stood as scene security at this time, until I was relieved by Sgt. Warren.

After being relieved from my post, I met with the other SWAT team members and was told to respond to RPD Magnolia station. While at the station, I was briefed to write a supplemental report and was released from my duties.
