While the negotiation process continued, I made constant phone calls to the victim's cell phone

At no time did anyone answer the phone and I could hear the phone ringing in the background of the intercom phone call we had on speaker phone. I continued doing this until entry was made and the situation was neutralized.

I was advised by ENT supervision to stand by in the ENT motorhome for a debrief. Once the debrief was over, I was cleared from the scene.
