On 11-9-17, I interviewed Witness Pasillas by phone. He is a custodian who was at Castle View School when the incident began.

Pasillas said that the kids were eating lunch in the quad and he was sweeping. He heard someone yelling, "Lock up. Lock up." He first thought it was a drill but realized it was not. He began escorting the kids to the Multi-Purpose Room (MPR) and locked the doors after the kids were inside.

Pasillas said that after he locked the kids inside the MPR, he heard Duke (Reveles) yelling. He ran to the area of classroom A-6 and saw a man with blood on his face. He did not know who the man was. Duke told him that a man had forced a teacher into the classroom. He and Duke went into the center room which connects to room A-6. He said he could hear the suspect inside the classroom barricading the doors with desks and chairs.

Pasillas said that he went back outside and saw two police officers. He took them to the center room. He then went back outside and saw a teacher and two kids. He locked them in a bathroom for their safety.

After he locked the teacher and kids in the bathroom, he saw approximately seven officers outside room A-6. The officers told him to come to them. He went to the officers and they asked him if he had keys to the rooms. He had keys so he gave them to the officers.

Pasillas was then escorted outside the campus by a female officer.

Pasillas said he never saw the suspect and did not see how the man's face became bloody. He also did not see how the suspect forced the teacher inside the classroom. All of this happened further int when he was locking the kids in the MPR.

Pasillas had no further information.
