Interview with Elizabeth Reyes

On 11-07-17 at approximately 1636 hours, partner Detective Beler and I interviewed Elizabeth Reyes in one of the interview rooms at the Magnolia Police Station. The interview was recorded on Detective Beler's Department issued digital recorder and later downloaded. The following is a summary of that interview.

Elizabeth said she had three girls who attended Castle View; two of them were twins in the first grade. She went to the school to pick up one of her daughters (Eva) for a doctor's appointment. She went to the front office, signed her out, and waited for her to come to the office. Mrs. Ferris was in the office. They had a brief conversation about the holiday. As they were talking, a lady walked into the office and up to Mrs. Ferris and in a calm yet quiet voice said, "I have an emergency. My son is on his way. Do not release his daughter to him." She said something like, "He had an episode." She wasn't sure if that was her exact words, but it was about some type of mental issue.

Mrs. Ferris took the woman into her office and closed the door. Elizabeth stood in the office processing what she just heard. She got into a conversation with Mrs. Lopez who was leaving for lunch and was kind of in a hurry. As she was talking to Mrs. Lopez, a guy came walking up the walk way and she remembered seeing him before and that he was tall, had a thin build, and didn't have great posture. She thought that he was wearing all dark clothing and might have had a back pack, but she wasn't completely sure about the clothing or back pack. As she was finishing her conversation with Mrs. Lopez, Mrs. Lopez turned to walk away and Elizabeth said to Mrs. Lopez that something was about to go down. She didn't know why she said that. Mrs. Lopez continued to walk away to go to lunch.

Elizabeth said the guy had passed her at that point and she turned and followed him into the office. Annette was the only one in the front office at that point. It was her, Kennon, and Annette. Annette told him he could go ahead and take a seat. She didn't hear him say anything. He was just pacing around. She walked outside the office and remembered thinking she didn't want to be

in the room with that guy and thought about the poor secretaries who had to stay in the office in a situation like that. She waited near the side gate for her daughter and began to think how she could avoid having to go into the office. A few minutes later Kennon came busting out the side door. Mrs. Ferris was right there with him as he came out and she had a look of terror on her face.

She told Kennon he couldn't go back there and that the police were on their way.

Elizabeth ran into the office as Mrs. Ferris screamed "lock down" before she continued going after Kennon. Elizabeth then also ran out after them to the court yard but at that point she couldn't see Kennon or Mrs. Ferris, but she saw teachers ushering the kids from the court yard to the NPR room. She ran over to the NPR room and grabbed and ran back towards the office. On the way back to the office she passed Sherry who was standing still, looking towards classroom A-1. She told Sherry there was a man loose on the campus and to get somewhere. Elizabeth turned to continue towards the office and as she rounded the corner she heard a woman screaming in the background behind her. She ran inside the office. All three secretaries were on the phone with Dispatch.

Elizabeth said Mrs. Ferris came up to the office door and started banging on it frantically. She unlocked the door to let Mrs. Ferris in. Mrs. Ferris was fumbling with something and said "He's beating Gallardo's husband." Mrs. Ferris ran back out and Elizabeth locked the door behind her. A few minutes later she let Mr. Gallardo into the office and locked it back up. Mr. Gallardo went to the nursing station but she wasn't there. Elizabeth remembered looking at him and seeing so much blood and thinking that his nose was probably broken. The whole time Kennon's mother was standing in the doorway of the Principal's office, standing there frozen holding her phone texting and calling people. Elizabeth gave Annette the description of Kennon for her to give to dispatch and she told her that he was carrying a back pack. Elizabeth then looked at Kennon's mother and asked her if he was armed and she said he was not. Gallardo added that Kennon had tattoos.

Elizabeth grabbed an ice pack for Gallardo and tried to find something to give him for the bleeding. Officers started to arrive at that point. Gallardo told Elizabeth that there was a teacher in

She described the back pack as a "slouchy" type with a draw string, but she wasn't sure. She remembered Kennon's ne h.
