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Interview with Duke Reveles:

The interview was conducted at Castle View Elementary School on 11/9/17 at approximately 0809 hours.

W/Reveles told Detective Tillett and me that he left campus on 10/31/17 to get lunch. When he returned to campus S/Kennon was already on campus. W/Reveles heard on the radio that S/Kennon was beating someone up. W/Reveles parked and went through the gate. He did not immediately go to the school administration office. He saw a parent volunteer running with a child. The parent told him to let her into the office. He let the parent and student into the office and then went to the lunch court.

W/Reveles saw a guy dragging a teacher into a classroom. He saw a male substitute teacher that seemed dazed and was bloodied. W/Reveles yelled to S/Kennon to stop and to leave V/Montgomery alone. S/Kennon kept going and dragged V/Montgomery inside. W/Reveles went to the aid of the substitute teacher and told him to back away from classroom in case S/Kennon came back out with a weapon. He then went to the classroom next to V/Montgomery's and went to the center pod area. W/Reveles heard S/Kennon pushing and throwing desks. He then saw through the window that S/Kennon was pushing desks. He, Stephanie and the Principal stayed back and maintained a visual of the class room. About 10 minutes later, the police arrived.

W/Reveles said the suspect was wearing a black top and jeans. He did not see him put V/Montgomery in a head lock but saw him pulling her by the hair. He didn't hear S/Kennon say anything to V/Montgomery. Initially, S/Kennon pulled her with one hand and held the classroom door with the other hand. He then quickened up and pulled her inside. W/Reveles didn't remember V/Montgomery screaming but remembered he tried to get S/Kennon to let her go. From the common area, W/Reveles heard things being moved. He remembered the windows were covered which was not normally the case. W/Reveles went to classroom A2 to look through the window. He then went into classroom A6 and got close to the wall to see if he could hear anything. He could hear the pushing of desks but didn't hear any talking or screaming.

W/Reveles said he did not see S/Kennon assault the substitute teacher. He saw the substitute teacher bloodied and going after S/Kennon in a staggering way. W/Reveles didn't see S/Kennon holding anything in his hands. He described S/Kennon as a black male who was tall and slender. He knew him as one of the student's father but didn't know him by name. W/Reveles told S/Kennon to let V/Montgomery go and to leave her alone. When W/Reveles looked into the room, he saw S/Kennon sitting down and saw him take a drink of something (possibly Gatorade) from a bottle. S/Kennon seemed calm. After officers arrived, W/Reveles saw smoke in the classroom and initially thought there was a fire.

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W/Reveles said he knew of no prior issues with S/Kennon on campus. S/Kennon usually just waited for his daughter. He never saw S/Kennon go on campus before. He told us they had a closed campus and talked about a picnic that was held there and remembered that S/Kennon was not there.

Interview with Sherry Lueck:

The interview was conducted at Castle View Elementary school on 11/9/17 at approximately 0822 hours.

W/Lueck said she was in the lunch court with the 1st and 2nd grade students on 10/31/17. She initially didn't see S/Kennon. She saw Ms. Ferris (*Principal*) running through the campus and yelling to lock it down. W/Lueck hustled the children into the Multi-Purpose Room. She then remembered there could be children in the bathroom. She went to check the bathrooms and saw no one was in there. She then heard V/Montgomery's classroom door fly open. She didn't know what happened but V/Montgomery was running out toward her and was bleeding from her head. W/Lueck told V/Montgomery to come to her and to run faster.

W/Lueck then saw Mr. Gallardo exit the classroom after V/Montgomery. She saw another guy run out after the two of them. W/Lueck tried to get V/Montgomery to come toward her and saw S/Kennon punch Mr. Gallardo in the face. Mr. Gallardo lost his balance and fell into V/Montgomery which caused her to fall to the ground. W/Lueck reached for V/Montgomery and tried to pull her up. S/Kennon grabbed V/Montgomery and raised a hand to W/Lueck as if he was going to hit her in the face. He gave her a weird look and put his hand down. He didn't hit W/Lueck.

S/Kennon had a hold of V/Montgomery and pulled her back. He pulled V/Montgomery away from W/Lueck. Ms. Ferris yelled at him to leave V/Montgomery alone and told him that she was just an old woman. S/Kennon pulled V/Montgomery into the classroom. Mr. Gallardo got up and was covered in blood. (He thanked W/Lueck later for yelling at S/Kennon not to hit him.)

Mr. Gallardo then went to the health office. W/Reveles returned from lunch, ran and yelled at S/Kennon right before S/Kennon closed the door. He yelled for S/Kennon to stop but S/Kennon didn't. W/Lueck heard sirens and went to the access gate and directed the police into the campus. She said she was not in the office when S/Kennon arrived.

W/Lueck described S/Kennon as a young, tall, very thin, black male. He was 5'11" or 6"0" tall and wore a multi-colored hoodie. She didn't see him with anything in his hand. She saw him grab V/Montgomery by the hair or collar and saw him drag her. V/Montgomery screamed, "I don't have her; I don't have your daughter; stop it." W/Lueck said she later realized that S/Kennon's daughter was with her in the lunch court. She saw blood on V/Montgomery's head. She didn't know if S/Kennon hurt her or if V/Montgomery fell. Mr. Gallardo was covered in

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blood. He had blood on his hands and on his shirt. She saw a cut on his nose and thought maybe his nose was broken.

After W/Lueck went to the gate, she then went to the park to assist parents with student pick-ups.

Interview with Annette Paramo:

The interview was conducted at Castle View Elementary School on 11/9/17 at approximately 0833 hours.

W/Paramo said she was in the front office by the printer when S/Kennon's mother came in. W/Paramo, Stephanie, Nilda and the Principal were present. S/Kennon's mother told them that they could not let her son pick up Aria from school. W/Paramo said she thought, "Who are you?" about the statement. S/Kennon's mother was advised that parents were allowed to pick up children. The grandmother told them that they didn't understand. The grandmother appeared fearful and W/Paramo heard the fear in her voice when she told them that they didn't understand. Stephanie and the Principal took the grandmother into the Principal's office and closed the door.

About two minutes later, S/Kennon walked in and stated he needed to pick up his daughter [REDACTED] early. He had a backpack over his shoulder. W/Paramo told us that she froze because she didn't know what to say. Stephanie told him that he would have to wait and they couldn't do that right now. S/Kennon asked since when couldn't a parent to pick up his child. He said he wanted to pick her up now.

W/Paramo told us that she had students waiting to go into the health office and she sent them into that room. S/Kennon got closer to the Principal's office. 911 had already been called. The phones started ringing because of the automated dialer and notification system and S/Kennon demanded his daughter immediately. He then saw his mother in the Principal's office and told her to come out and that he needed to talk to her.

W/Paramo said S/Kennon looked different than the previous times that she had contact with him. He picked up his daughter frequently and sometimes called the office to explain why he was late. He was always nice and signed his daughter out and then left without incident.

S/Kennon told his mother to come out of the office and she refused. He loudly told W/Paramo to open the office door. W/Paramo told him that she couldn't because she didn't have the key. She got scared directed the two children to go into the health office. S/Kennon went to the glass door. W/Paramo told him to remember he needed to sign in and to get a sticker before he went onto campus.

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S/Kennon told W/Paramo to go get his daughter now. She told him to wait and he waved at his mother. His mother waved at him to come to her and he told W/Paramo to tell his mother to come out. His mother was crying and calling him over. W/Paramo told him to look that his mom was calling him to come to the office. He then told W/Paramo to look that his mom was calling him. W/Paramo glanced away from him and he ran out the door and onto the campus. Tiffany and Stephanie ran after him. Stephanie ran back and said they were calling for a lock down. This meant, the blinds were closed and everything was locked down. W/Paramo went into the health office with the two kids because she was responsible for them.

Over the radio, Tiffany asked where the police were and told her to call again. Nilda called once and W/Paramo called again. W/Paramo said she told 911 that the police were needed now. She was talking to the 911 dispatcher and looking through the window. The dispatcher told her that it had been nine minutes since the first call and asked her to describe who was outside and who was in the office. W/Paramo saw Tiffany and Stephanie outside. She also saw Duke by the library. She saw an officer come onto campus with his gun drawn. The dispatcher then told W/Paramo to back away from the window. When the Principal returned to the office she appeared to be full of panic and scared. When Carlos came into the health office, she saw a lot of blood. W/Paramo handed him a tissue and someone else helped him until the paramedics arrived.

She moved to the copy room with the two students and waited for about 45 minutes until the students and the parent with the daughter were evacuated.

She said S/Kennon was wearing sweat pants and shirt or sweater. She didn't remember the color. He carried a small colorful backpack. She didn't know him by name but knew that he was Aria's dad. He had picked his daughter up since last year and W/Paramo knew his face. He was a tall, slim, Black male. She knew that she was unable to fight him off. She said he was really tall and she knew that she was not going to be able to physically stop him.

She said he was very different on 10/31/17 than previous times that she had contact with him. She said he had a tough look about him that could be intimidating but that day, he had a lost look. She thought that he didn't look okay and that something was wrong with him. When he called for his mom, it was if he was a 6 year old boy. His mom was locked in the office and was looking out. W/Paramo didn't know why the office was locked.

W/Paramo told us that she was trying to distract him because she knew he wanted to run out on campus. He knew that she was staring at him. He didn't sign in at the office and he knew that he needed to because he knew the process. She said all parents knew the process. She remembered his mom saying that they didn't understand. His mother didn't sign in either. She said the Principal's office door locked and no one could get in unless they had a key. She said S/Kennon never tried to get physical with her but did get loud when he told her to open the office door for him.
