On 11-09-17 at approximately 0800 hours, partner Detective Beler and I went to Castle View to interview several staff members who witnessed the incident (see Detective Beler's supplemental report for three of the interviews). This report covered our interviews with Julia Cook and Tiffany Farris. I later interviewed Nilda Cancino over the phone on 11-20-17. The interviews were recorded on my Department issued digital recorder and later downloaded. The following are summaries of those interviews.

Interview of Julia Cook

Cook said she was in classroom B1. She heard "lock down" over the intercom. She had just released her students back to their classrooms, so she locked her door. Her aid was in the room with her. Cook was also the "Admin Designee", but she hadn't heard what had happened so she looked out her window to see what was going on. She saw the Principal running across the courtyard so she knew it probably wasn't a drill. She told her aid to go to the center Pod, and she also went to see who else was in the Pod area. She went into the classroom next to hers where she could see out to the lunch court.

Cook saw one of the new duty supervisors standing in the middle of the lunch tables and two other men who she didn't recognize. One was Hispanic and the other was African American. The African American man was on top of the Hispanic man and he was hitting him repeatedly to the point where she saw the Hispanic man fall to the ground. She heard the Principal yelling. Cook realized she needed to make sure all of the Pod doors were locked. She ran through and locked all of the Pod doors.

When she went back to the classroom, she saw Ms. Farris close to classroom A1, looking into the windows. Cook saw that the Hispanic male was bleeding a lot. She went back and counted all the kids in the classrooms and realized a lot of the kids were not in the right place, so they must have been out on the playground. When she realized the incident was not ending, she gathered all the kids into the center Pod and stayed there until the police came and evacuated them. She said the whole ordeal was frightening. This concluded the interview.

Interview of Tiffany Farris

Farris was the Principal of Castle View. She said she was standing in the front office with her secretary when Kennon's mom came in. The mother told her that her son was on the way there and he was having a rough time (or something to that effect), that she couldn't let him take his daughter, and that if she (Farris) didn't call the police she would. Farris had the mother accompany her into her office. Farris tried to get a hold of the School Resource Officer but then ended up calling 911. While she was on the phone with 911, her secretary said Kennon was walking up to the office. Farris shut her office door.

Farris said she could hear Kennon ask to pick up his daughter, and she could hear he was getting angry. He looked into her office and saw his mother in there. He started banging on the window and told his mother to come out, but she wouldn't. Farris knew the mother was really scared of him because she wouldn't go out and talk to him. Farris heard him say something like he was going to get his daughter no matter what. Farris walked out of her office and ran after Kennon, after she called for a lockdown. Kennon went right towards Ms. Montgomery's room and stood by the door. She told Kennon he didn't have to do this. Kennon ripped her lanyard off from around her neck. She didn't know if he was trying to pull her into the classroom, but she had a breakaway lanyard, and he was surprised when it just broke away. Kennon then went in and shut the classroom door.

She ran to the other door to the classroom, located inside the center Pod, and that's when she saw Kennon grabbing Montgomery to keep her from leaving the classroom. Montgomery told him she didn't have his daughter and asked him why he was doing this. Farris told Kennon not to hurt Montgomery and that she was an old lady. Kennon was trying to barricade the door. That's when the teacher's husband (Gallardo) came and pushed passed her and into the classroom. She wasn't sure if she followed Gallardo into the room, or went out through another room, but she ended up in the quad area and she saw that Kennon did not have a hold of Montgomery anymore. She told Montgomery to run, run, run. Montgomery tried to run.

Farris said Kennon was pounding on Gallardo to the point where she thought he was going to kill him. She ran back to the office and asked where the police were. She ran back out to the quad area and everyone was gone. She asked Stephanie where was Montgomery and she said that Kennon had dragged her back into the room. She went back to the center Pod to try to look into the classroom, but there was a piece of paper in the window so she couldn't see in. She then went to check on some of the kids before going out to the front of the school to wait for the police.

She described Kennon as tall (6'04"-6'05"), thin, African American, who in the past was very quiet and unassuming until that day. He was wearing a colorful jacket (mix a different colors) of some sort. She knew he had a back pack but she wasn't sure if she actually saw the back pack or just heard about it after the fact. We asked her to describe the assault of Mr. Gallardo. She said Kennon was on top of him and he was hitting him over and over again to the point where she was really scared he was going to kill him or seriously hurt him.

We asked her to elaborate on the conversation with Kennon's mother. Farris said the mother was very distressed and said he was having a "PTSD" episode, was on his way there, was going to try to take his daughter, and that it wouldn't be safe for him to take her. Farris could tell by her tone that she was serious. Farris said she had a birthday poster in her office that she took from the classroom. Everybody's name was erased except for and it was written next to the date, "the 30th." Farris thought that maybe that was birthday and he (Kennon) must have erased everyone else's, but that date was not her birthday. Farris wasn't sure if Kennon wrote on the poster but she thought it was interesting. This concluded the interview.

Interview of Nilda Cancino

Cancino said at around 1050 hours, a lady came in and said her son was having an episode and that he was on his way to the school to pick up her grand-daughter. Ms. Farris called her into the office with the secretary and they closed the door. The secretary came out and dialed 911, and as she was doing that the guy (Kennon) came into the office. Cancino had interacted with him in the past and she noticed he was not in a good state. He was very sweaty and agitated. He walked up to Stephanie's desk and asked her to call for his daughter. She told him no and he

became agitated. She told him she was calling the police and he started to pace back and forth and seemed very upset.

He then asked Annette if she would call for his daughter. Annette told him she didn't know what was happening. He then walked over to Cancino's side of the desk. He had two back packs with him that he placed on the counter. He asked her if she would call for his daughter. She told him she would wait for the Principal to come out of her office to tell her what was going on and then she would call for his daughter. He walked over to the Principal's door. He knocked on the door and asked his mom to come out and told her that he needed to talk to her. She refused to come out. The mother told Kennon that she could hear him through the door, but he wanted her to come out. She wouldn't come out and seemed very afraid.

He started to walk towards the glass door the lead onto the campus. Ms. Farris came out of the office and told Kennon he couldn't go onto the campus. He then suddenly opened the door and ran onto the campus. Ms. Farris ran after him and announced lockdown. The secretary also ran after them. Cancino locked the door and closed the curtain and basically followed the lockdown procedures. She mentioned there was a parent (Elizabeth Reyes) in the office that was waiting to pick up her child who also ran after the guy but then returned to the office and locked the door. Shortly after that, the teacher's husband (Gallardo) came to the office and he was all beat up and his nose wouldn't stop bleeding.

She heard over the walkie-talkie that they were asking where the police were, so she called 911 again. She told the dispatcher what was going on and that a teacher had been taken hostage. She didn't know which teacher it was, but remembered hearing someone screaming when she opened and closed the office door a few minutes earlier. The police arrived and the negotiators came into the office. She was told they were going to evacuate the school, so she took the attendance books and eventually ended up at the park where she assisted with the release of the children to their parents.

She described the suspect as Mr. Kennon, African American, and tall. She wasn't sure about his clothing but was sure he had two black back packs with him. She said they appeared to be heavy but she didn't see what was in them. He was very sweaty and agitated. When the mom said he was having an episode, she wasn't sure if she meant a mental episode or a drug relapse because he wouldn't make eye contact, his face was twitching, and he was agitated, restless, and pacing back and forth. She said he was totally out of character from how he normally was when she dealt with him in the past. This concluded the interview.
