On 02-20-17, at about 2253 hours I responded to the area of 4041 MacArthur Rd. regarding an officer involved shooting. I arrived onscene and took a containment spot at MacArthur and Hawthorne until a high-risk stop was completed on an involved vehicle. Sergeant McCoy requested my assistance with a search team to conduct a safety sweep of the property at 4051 MacArthur. When we walked down the driveway I noticed pools of blood and a blood trail leading towards the back of the property. I also saw a cell phone, hat and T-shirt in the driveway. At that time the search team backed off of the property. Moments later, Officer Eric Garcia broadcasted he had located more blood on Hawthorne and MacArthur. I responded to Officer Garcia's location and we followed the blood trail. The blood trail was actually a bloody foot print which continued north on MacArthur along the east sidewalk. The prints continued east on Sage along the south sidewalk. About mid block, the bloody footprints crossed the street in a north east direction across the grass and into the driveway of [Redacted]. The last print I was able to see was to the front of [Redacted].

I held on this location until METRO personnel arrived onscene.

Once METRO I arrived I was tasked with assigning officers to receive occupants of adjacent residences as well as the primary location the suspect was believed to be located [REDACTED] Approximately twenty occupants from [REDACTED] were escorted to the corner of MacArthur and Sage, where they were identified and interviewed by patrol officers.

At approximately 0535 hours, I was contacted by Lieutenant Blomdahl and told to speak with O/Moreno (resident/lessee to [REDACTED]) regarding consent to deploy a throw phone inside his residence in an attempt to make contact with the suspect. I spoke with O/Moreno who gave me consent for the police to put a throw phone inside of his residence. My conversation with O/Moreno was audio recorded with Officer Leyva's #1762 department issued Puma recorder and later downloaded.

I remained on scene for security and supervision at MacArthur and Sage until 1230 hours (02/21/17).
