Narrative:

On 02/20/17 at approximately 2342 hours, I received a text message from Officer Smith (#1275), that SWAT personnel had been activated; reference an officer involved shooting. The text also stated the suspect was still outstanding and still believed to be armed. After receiving the notification, I drove to the Aviation Hangar and picked up the Armored Rescue Vehicle (ARV); and drove the ARV to the command post, which was located at Garfield Ave & Van Buren Blvd.

At approximately 0035 hours (02/21/17) I was assigned by Sgt. Corbett to the Emergency Response Team (ERT) and directed to the area of 9321 Sage; where a blood trail was located. Upon arrival, SWAT personnel received a brief from Sgt. Ortiz (#1377) regarding patrol officers following a blood trail up the driveway to [REDACTED], but stopped due to officer safety concerns. Sgt. Ortiz advised there had not been any communication between the occupants of [REDACTED] and patrol officers.

After receiving the above stated information, Sgt. Ortiz gained access to a telephone number associated to [REDACTED] (Which sat on the same parcel as [REDACTED]) Within minutes, 10-12 people started to exit the residence, and SWAT personnel provided protection as they were escorted away from the area.

During the process of escorting residents of [REDACTED], SWAT personnel (Officer Smith) saw a HMA running around the eastern portion of [REDACTED]. During this time, SWAT personnel attempted to give verbal commands to the HMA, but he did not listen and disappeared into the eastern side of the property.

After SWAT personnel escorted everybody out the west side of the residence, the ARV was driven up the driveway; and positioned to the front of the right-side of the house. Once SWAT personnel were safety set up to the rear of the ARV, SWAT personnel started to provide verbal announcements via P.A. After a couple of announcements, 6-8 HMA's and HFA's exited the eastern side of the residence. As they exited, the Hispanic adults were escorted out of the immediate area; and handed over to patrol officers.

Once the Hispanic adults were secure, SWAT personnel continued with P.A. announcements, to no avail. Approximately two hours later, I was assigned by Sgt. Corbett to activate the Avatar II tactical robot, and safely clear the residence via video/audio feed. After I assembled the robot, I remotely drove the robot inside the eastern portion of [REDACTED], and into the garage.

After I visually cleared the garage, I left the robot sit stationary; to provide visual/audio coverage while I assembled the second Avatar robot. After I assembled the second robot, I drove the robot through the garage and up a couple of steps and into a washroom area. I cleared the washroom area, and come across an open interior door to the living area of the residence. I was able to enter the residence, and came into a kitchen area. After clearing the kitchen area, I then drove the robot to what appeared to be a family room/ living room area.

While operating the robot in and around the family room, I noticed a dark colored substance on the floor of the residence. The dark colored substance appeared to be blood, because it was dark in color and was smeared across as if somebody was dragging a foot.

After clearing the family room, I then drove the robot into the hallway which contained a couple of bedrooms and a small bathroom. While clearing the bedrooms, I continued to see a smeared trail of blood; but never saw

or heard S/Garcia. I drove the robot into the bathroom, and noticed an increased amount of blood and footmarks on the tile. I rotated the camera on the robot to the bathtub, and attempted to raise the robot's front flippers, in an attempt to look into the bathtub; but was unsuccessful.

After clearing the interior of the residence, I backed the robot out of the living quarters and positioned it in front of some stairs that led up to; what appeared to be an attic/crawl space. I attempted to climb the stairs with the robot, but was unsuccessful, because the stairs were too steep for the robot to manipulate and there was a broken wooden stair. Due to S/Garcia's unknown current location, I left the robot's video camera positioned at the entrance/exit to the attic space.

At approximately 0703 hours, SWAT personnel were assigned to port a window along the west side of the residence; and introduce chemical agent(s) into the residence. I assisted Officer Allison, by providing him cover while he completed the operation. Upon completion of the plan, I assisted Officer Allison to the west portion of the property and participated in a containment spot.

Upon the completion of the entire chemical agent plan, SWAT personnel along the eastern side of the residence advised they could see smoke/flames coming from the residence. Immediately after SWAT personnel advised of the smoke/flames billowing from the house, I heard a gunshot come from within the residence.

I remained at my containment spot, until Sgt. Corbett needed my assistance in removing the robots from the interior of the residence. I was able to maneuver the robots out of the residence, and returned them to the rear of the ARV.

At approximately 0716 hours, I was assigned to the north side of the residence to assist SWAT personnel with fire hoses and apply water to the fire. Minutes later, Riverside Fire personnel arrived and took over the firefighting efforts, while SWAT personnel provided them with protection.

SWAT personnel was later cleared from the scene by Sgt. Corbett.
