1 **Narrative:**

2 On 02-21-17, at approximately 0000 hours, I responded to the area of Garfield St and MacArthur St
3 reference an officer involved shooting. I am currently assigned as a member of the collateral METRO
4 (SWAT) team. I was activated in response to help locate a suspect who had shot at RPD Officers and was
5 now at large in the above listed area.

7 I arrived on scene and checked in with the command post. I was assigned with Sgt. McCoy, Officer
8 Hammer, and Officer Paes as part of the react team. I was stationed at the intersection of MacArthur St
9 and Saffron St which was the street north of where the suspect was last seen. I was assigned to this area
10 while another team conducted yard-to-yard searches on Sage St, in the event the suspect fled north onto
11 Saffron St.

12
13 I heard Sgt. Corbett advise over the radio that the suspect had been seen running to the rear of [REDACTED]
14 [REDACTED] Sgt. Corbett ordered our team to begin clearing houses on the south side of Saffron St to set up a
15 perimeter around the residence. Along with the react team, we cleared the rear yards of [REDACTED]
16 [REDACTED]

18 Officer Hammer and I took up a rear containment position in the rear yard of [REDACTED] This gave
19 me a clear view of the N/E corner of the residence where the suspect was barricaded. Officer Hammer and
20 I maintained this position for the remainder of the operation.

21
22 At approximately 0700 hours I observed the gas team move up to the N/E corner of the residence and
23 deploy the burn safe into the attached patio/garage area. A few seconds after the burn safe was deployed I
24 saw a basketball sized ball of flame flare up in the center of the room. The fire quickly spread to the
25 curtains and ceiling of the room. After approximately five to ten minutes I heard what sounded like a
26 single gunshot coming from the north side of the residence.

28 I maintained my rear containment spot until RFD arrived to my location and provided us with fire hoses
29 to put out the fire. I maintained lethal cover of the residence while RPD SWAT members attempted to
30 extinguish the fire. Eventually RFD responded to my location and took over the firefighting duties.

32 At approximately 1100 hours I was cleared from my containment spot and left the scene.
