Incident Number: On 2-20-17 at approximately 2253 hours, partner Officer Ouk and I were working uniformed patrol and assigned to call sign "3R36" driving unit 3539. We were at the Orange Street Police Station when we heard a unit broadcast "shots fired." Officer Ouk (driver) and I drove towards the west end of the city. As we were driving to the location, "3R40" broadcasted that an officer involved shooting had occurred at 4041 Mac Arthur Rd. Officers Carmona and Espinoza broadcasted that the suspect involved in the shooting was last seen travelling north/east over some fences.	Reporting Officer R. Serrato Reviewed By T. Banks COPIES TO
arrived at the location and saw a Kia Soul occupied by several subjects that were related to the suspect. A high risk stop was conducted on the vehicle and all occupants were detained. In an effort to render the immediate area safe, we conducted a search of the driveway located at [Redacted] and continued searching east. locations in the driveway. Based on where the blood was, we believed the suspect may have been struck by gunfire and was possibly heading north/east from the location (a side gate to [REDACTED] was ajar).

We then went to [REDACTED] and conducted a safety sweep of the back yard. While in the back yard of [REDACTED], we looked over the chain link fence of [REDACTED] and located a pair of dickies pants (or shorts) in the rear yard of [REDACTED]. We advised Sgt. McCoy of the clothing we had located and the decision was made that METRO was going to be contacted for a search team.

I responded to the command post located at Mac Arthur and Garfield and I was informed that I needed to take a perimeter spot on Kingsbury, between Sage and Saffron Ct. Officer Ouk and I drove to [REDACTED] and entered the back yard. Once in the back yard, we had a good look of the east side of the residence ("4-side") located at [REDACTED]. Officer Ouk and I maintained visual on the 4-side of the residence while several flashbangs and less lethal munitions were deployed at the residence.

I was later contacted by Officer Soria and Allison. They advised that myself, Officer Ouk, Officer Watters, and Officer Crocker were going to be assigned a gas mission. We were assigned to be "George-4" and our mission was to deploy a "burn safe" on the 4-side of the residence. We were instructed to deploy gas on the 4-side, near the north end of the residence into a large addition of the home. The window we chose to deploy the burn safe was a window located on the north side of the addition, on the east side of the property (the window faced north).

At approximately 0702 hours, "George-1" initiated the gas mission. "George-2,3, and 4" were then instructed to initiate the gas mission. At approximately 0707 hours, Officers Ouk, Watters, Crocker and I approached the residence. I pulled the safety pin from the burn safe and noticed it began to emit gas. I deployed the "burn safe" into the window on the north side of the addition, causing the window to break. I was standing approximately 5-feet from the window when I swung the burn safe into the home. Within approximately three seconds of deploying the burn safe, I saw flames beginning to ignite a curtain on the east side of the residence near the location in which I had deployed the "burn safe." I broadcasted that the gas mission was successful but a fire had started on the 4-side of the residence. I tied off the end of the rope onto a chain link fence on the north side of the property. Officers Ouk, Watters, Crocker and I walked back to [REDACTED] and we maintained visual of the 4-side of the residence.

Riverside Fire Department personnel responded to the location and I assisted other Officers by deploying a fire hose and soaking the residence with water. I remained at [REDACTED] until approximately 1100 hours.

Officer Ouk and I cleared the scene at approximately 1200 hours. No further information.
