The incident was regarding an attempted murder on a Police Officer and a tactical response was initiated. I responded to the scene, which was identified as the intersection of Garfield St./McArthur Rd. (City/County of Riverside, CA.).			Reviewed By
Upon arrival, I made contact with other operators and supervision of METRO for my assignment. It was determined the suspect who shot at the Police Officers was inside of [Redacted] (City/County of Riverside, CA.). At this time, I was tasked by Sgt. Corbett to maintain over watch for our approach to the listed address. I took my position in the Armored Rescue Vehicle's (known as an ARV) open hatch in the roof.			COPIES TO

Upon arriving at the above mentioned address, the ARV was parked in the drive way at a distance of approximately 40 feet from the south wall of the location. I then maintained my cover watch for approximately 2 and a half hours. At this time, I exchanged my position with another Officer, to take a break from being overexerted.

After a break for approximately 30 minutes, I returned to my position in the opened hatch in the ARV. After another period as cover watch in the ARV, I was tasked by Sgt. McCoy to assist with team of operators in the deployment of a chemical agent, into the window of the second story loft window, located on the south side of the residence. I provided lethal cover on the left edge of the team as we approached the location and deployed the chemical agent device into the window.

After deployment of the chemical agent into this window, I was tasked with assisting another team of operators, in the deployment of additional chemical agent on the west side of the residence. I moved with the team of operators, towards a large window located on the west wall of the residence. I provided lethal cover on the window, while the chemical agent was deployed into the window. Immediately after the deployment of the chemical agent, we retreated to cover to the rear separated structure on the same property, away from the primary residence.

While waiting in this position, I saw dark smoke coming from the residence. I then hear radio communication, stating a fire had started inside the residence. I then saw the dark smoke grow and fire was now visible throughout the entire residence. Due to the wanted subject potentially still being inside of the structure, along with the fire growing, I responded to the front of the residence to assist other operators in extinguishing the fire. Riverside Fire Department had provided hoses to the front of the residence and I took turns with other operators in spraying the fire to the residence, in hopes to extinguish it. This was also done to ensure other structures did not catch fire.

After approximately 40 minutes of attempting to extinguish the fire, Riverside Fire personnel arrived to assist. As they were tending to the fire, I provided lethal cover for them, because the status of the suspect inside of the residence was still unknown. At approximately 1120 hours, the fire appeared to be contained and I was relieved from providing lethal cover for fire personnel on scene. Shortly after being relieved from my duties as force protection, I was released from the scene.
