**Witness Contacts and Interviews:**

[REDACTED]

On February 21, 2017, I was conducting the crime scene investigation for this incident. I saw a female that I later identified as [REDACTED]. She is the resident at [REDACTED]. I asked [REDACTED] if any officer has spoken to her yet related to the incident in question and she replied, "No." I spoke to her inside her home and our conversation was audio recorded.

[REDACTED] said on February 20, 2017 she went to bed around 1930 – 2000 hours. At approximately 2230 hours she was woken up by the sound of gunshots. [REDACTED] opened her front door so she could see what was going on. She had her cell phone in her hand and was going to call 911 but she saw a police car so she never made the call. [REDACTED] described hearing, "Rapid loud bangs" that she thought at first was somebody banging on her door. She said she realized they were gunshots after she opened the door and saw a police officer. She saw one officer across the street shining a flashlight and she described seeing smoke and smelling gunpowder. [REDACTED] said the officer yelled in her direction to, "Get out!" or possibly "Come out! or something similar.

[REDACTED] said she could not see the gold Kia vehicle from her vantage point at first and she thought the officer was yelling at her because his light was shining towards her door. Then she saw the Kia and noted two males in the front driver side seat and passenger side seat of the car. They had their hands held out the window of both sides of the car. [REDACTED] said that she was concerned for the officer at first because she thought he was alone. She never saw a second officer until minutes later when additional police cars with their emergency lights on started to arrive on scene.

I asked [REDACTED] about the gunshots or "Banging" sound that she heard. She described hearing two separate volleys. The first volley she described as being more than 10 shots from very close to her house. After a pause of, "Maybe one minute," the second volley was approximately 5 more gunshots. The second volley of gunshots appeared to be further away from her house than the other shots were.

[REDACTED] said after the gunshots ended she opened her front door. She heard, "The Officers" make commands to the people in the [REDACTED]. She saw the primary officer that she saw earlier with additional back up officers take the two males out of the [REDACTED] and take them into custody. [REDACTED] looked across the street and noted that there was another police officer who had a female with long hair detained as well. She did not think the female came from the [REDACTED] but she wasn't sure.

After all the police arrived on scene and had people in custody, [REDACTED] left her front door opened but she went inside her house. She also heard a helicopter and assumed that the police were still looking for somebody else so she just stayed inside her home. No further details.

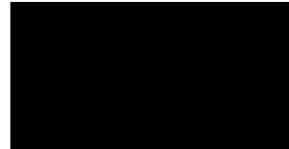

On February 21, 2017 while conducting the crime scene investigation I contacted [REDACTED] at his home at [REDACTED]. The suspect's blood trail was located on [REDACTED] long driveway.

[REDACTED] said he was sleeping on the couch in his living room which is just north of the driveway. He woke up because he heard gunshots. [REDACTED] said he saw only the shadow of a person from the living room window that faces the driveway. The person was standing on the sidewalk just outside of the window. He described hearing 4 gunshots and seeing the "Lighting" from the gun meaning muzzle flash. [REDACTED] said he heard the noise of someone opening the gate leading to his rear yard. He told the other occupants in the house to stay inside because he thinks the person who shot was now in their back yard. [REDACTED] said he then heard a sound coming from the side yard on the north side of his rear yard like maybe the person had jumped over the fence into a neighboring yard.

I asked [REDACTED] to try and clarify how many shots he heard. He said he heard 3-4 shots first and then a brief pause of less than a minute before he heard several more gunshots and saw the muzzle flash 3 or 4 times. He did not hear any voices and he just stayed inside his house. [REDACTED] said he used his cell phone to call 911 and report the incident.



On February 24, 2017 at approximately 1700 hours I spoke to [REDACTED] at his home at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said on the night in question he was woken up by the sound of gunshots. He said first he heard 2-3 gunshots followed by a brief pause. Then he heard a volley of approximately 14 more gunshots followed by another very brief pause. Then [REDACTED] said he heard 10-12 more gunshots and another brief pause. [REDACTED] said he heard 3 final gunshots before they stopped.

[REDACTED] said he stayed inside his home during the entire incident but was watching police arrive on scene from his bedroom window. No further information.
