I am a Detective with the Riverside Police Department assigned to the Gang Intelligence Unit. On Tuesday, February 21st, 2017 at approximately 0830 hours, I was contacted by Sgt. LeVesque and asked to respond to incident to assist the homicide detectives.

NARRATIVE

I responded to the command post at Garfield St and MacArthur Road and met with Detectives O'Boyle and Medici.

I was asked to assist with searching the brown Kia vehicle, bearing California license plate 7LBU774. I search the driver side of the vehicle. On the front driver door panel, I located a clear plastic bottle that contained numerous unknown type pills. On the driver seat was a black/ dark gray smartphone. On the floorboard of the driver seat, I located a red "Target" credit card. I later set those items aside, per Detective Medici's request. Those items were later collected and booked into evidence.

Pepe's Tow later arrived on-scene and towed the suspect vehicle, a gold Saturn, from the scene. The vehicle was taken to the Magnolia St police station where it was stored as evidence, per Detective Medici's request. I entered the vehicle into the system at approximately 1300 hours via PSD #1470.

I was released from the scene by Detective Medici. I took no further action in this investigation.
