Narrative:

On 02-24-17, at approximately 1000 hours, I prepared to serve a search warrant (#RI022720172) on S/ Garcia's vehicle, which had been towed to the Riverside Police Department Magnolia Station for processing. Detective O'Boyle wrote the search warrant, which was signed by the Honorable Judge Gail O'Rane. (See Detective O'Boyle's Supplemental Report for details)

I began by taking photographs of the vehicle. The vehicle did not have a front license plate and the rear license plate (6LMC505) was covered with an "EZ finance auto sales" paper plate. The top of the front windshield had "AX3" in raised number/letters stickers. "AX3" is commonly used to identify a Riverside criminal street gang known as "Arlanza 13."

Detective D. Smith (#444) and I then searched the vehicle. While searching the vehicle I noticed the center console under the dash on the passenger side was not secured properly. Detective Smith pulled

the panel back and found a black handgun hidden inside. Detective Smith removed the gun and found it to be a "Bear River" .177cal pellet handgun (JMB001). On the back of the driver's seat was a plastic mask with an elastic band (JMB002). I also found and collected three (3) black cotton gloves that were in the center console and on the passenger seat. I found a white Samsung cell phone and a black iPod 8GB (JMB004) in the dashboard, under the stereo. I found a black LG Verizon cell phone (JMB005), a white iPhone in multicolor case and a black HTC 4G LTE Verizon cell phone (JMB006) in the center console between the front seats. Inside the driver's door panel, I found a black iPod 80GB (JMB007) and an orange iPod 8GB (JMB008) was found plugged into the vehicle's stereo.

Detective Smith found a camouflage backpack in the trunk of the vehicle and inside found five (5) additional cell phones (JMB009). Detective Smith collected the phones (see above for descriptions) and returned the backpack to the trunk. Detective Smith also collected the "EZ finance auto sales" paper plate (JMB010).

We concluded the search at approximately 1030 hours and I took possession of all evidence items, which I booked at the Magnolia Station.

Narrative:

On 02-20-17, at approximately 2315 hours, I was contacted by Sergeant T. Banks and asked to respond to MacArthur Rd and Garfield Avenue to assist on an Officer Involved Shooting Investigation. I arrived in the area at approximately 0010 hours (02-21-17).

I attended a briefing of the incident provided by Lieutenant D. Hoxmeier, Sergeant S. Goodson and Sergeant W. McCoy. Following the briefing, I was assigned to assist Detective M. Medici and Senior Forensic Technician S. McKay-Davis with processing the crime scene. The documentation of the scene was done by Detective M. Medici (Refer to his Supplemental Report for details).

While at the scene, I spoke with [REDACTED] who lives [REDACTED] [REDACTED] which is the property just south of where the suspect was seen running by officers. The interview was audio recorded and later downloaded. Below is a synopsis.

[REDACTED] was asleep in his bed with his wife, [REDACTED] when he was awoken by a "pop" sound that he described as a gunshot. After hearing the first single gunshot he heard approximately six (6) more gunshots coming from the driveway of the houses [REDACTED] outside his bedroom window. He said it sounded like the shots were right outside his window. He and his wife got out of bed and his wife told him someone was knocking at the back door. He told her nobody is knocking at the door the sound was gunshots.

[REDACTED] said he was sound asleep when this happened so he was uncertain about the time. He did not hear any arguing or yelling before the shots and never looked outside to see muzzle flash.
