Narrative of Supplemental Report:

Narrative:

On Friday, 07-20-18, around 1946 hours, partner Officer Adams and I were working as members of the University Neighborhood Enhancement Team (UNET) and were driving unit N005 (UCR PD Unit/Not equipped with COBAN). As we arrived at RPD Orange station, we heard RPD communications broadcast Hemet PD was in pursuit of a silver Chrysler 200 (CA. plate 7JPW282) on the northbound I-215 freeway, heading towards the city of Riverside. Communications also broadcast the suspect was shooting at Officers, while they pursued him.

As the pursuit approached the city limits, the suspect vehicle exited the freeway and began to drive southbound on Van Buren Blvd. Hemet PD requested RPD units respond to take over the pursuit. As the vehicle exited the freeway, communications advised additional shots were fired at Police Officers. As RPD units began to take over as primary units in the pursuit, it continued southbound on Van Buren Blvd., towards the area of Victoria Ave. As we drove to the above mentioned area, the suspect vehicle turned eastbound on Dufferin St.

The above listed area is a large set orange groves, I made an eastbound turn onto Victoria Ave. to establish a perimeter if the suspect fled the vehicle.

I was driving east on Victoria Ave. and approached Jackson St., when the suspect turned north onto Jackson St., heading in our direction. I stopped several yard away from Jackson St. and took cover. As the suspect passed us, the vehicle turned westbound onto Victoria Ave. and accelerated at a high rate of speed. I chose to stay in the area to assist units if needed at the conclusion of the pursuit.

While in the area, we heard Air-1 broadcast the pursuit was heading eastbound on Indiana Ave., towards Van Buren Blvd. We were currently at Van Buren Blvd./Lincoln Ave. As we drove to the listed intersection, we stopped our vehicle and exited. I began to yell at motorists near me to stay inside of their vehicles and to get down, because I did not know if the suspect was going to attempt to fire shots at them or other Officers in the area. As the suspect arrived at the intersection, he continued eastbound on Indiana Ave.

As pursuing Police vehicles passed through the intersection, I pulled in behind the pursuit and activated my overhead lights and sirens, and began to follow them as the number three unit. I continued eastbound on Indiana Ave. and made a northbound turn onto Monroe St. I then turned eastbound onto Magnolia Ave., at which time the suspect began to drive eastbound Magnolia Ave., in the westbound lanes. I stayed in the eastbound lanes of Magnolia Ave. as I approached Adams St. The suspect then turned northbound on Adams St. and accelerated at a high rate of speed.

I turned onto Adams St., we followed the suspect, however kept a large distance between us and him, due to the fact he had already fired shots at Officers. The suspect then turned eastbound onto California Ave. towards Streeter Ave. As we approached the intersection of California Ave./Streeter Ave., the suspect pulled into the dead end of California Ave. and drove over the concrete curbing, which now put him on Arlington Ave. I followed behind him and continued to pursue him as he drove eastbound on Arlington Ave. While driving eastbound, the suspect pulled into westbound traffic lanes, while driving eastbound. I stayed in the eastbound lanes and continued to pursue him as the number three unit in the pursuit.

As I approached Palomar Way, the suspect turned northbound onto Palomar Way. He then turned onto Granada Ave., now heading east. As he accelerated up to speeds of 60mph, he continued to show no regard for public safety in the residential area. The unit in front of me was unable to continue in the pursuit and I now became the number two unit in the pursuit.

I approached the Arch Way, the suspect turned onto Arch Way, now heading south. As Arch Way ends, it turns west into El Molino Ave. The suspect continued to drive west, towards the dead end of El Molino Ave. The suspect then turned south onto Valencia St. and then immediately turned onto Arlington Ave., now heading west. As we turned onto Arlington Ave. and continued to pursue the suspect, he swerved into on-coming traffic and was now driving westbound Arlington Ave., in eastbound lanes of travel. I continued to pursue by staying in the westbound lanes. I came to the intersection of Arlington Ave./Streeter Ave., the suspect vehicle came to a stop and the driver side door opened and it appeared the suspect was exiting his vehicle. Due to all traffic being stopped, I pulled into the eastbound lanes and Officer Adams and I exited our vehicles to pursue the suspect. As we were approaching the Police vehicle in front of us (Sgt. Elliot's unit) I heard a shots being fired. I was unaware where the shot was coming from, so I immediately took cover behind Sgt. Elliot's unit and held lethal cover on the vehicle. (Passenger Side)

While covering the vehicle, I was given a ballistic shield by assisting Officers and moved to the driver's side area of Sgt. Elliots' vehicle. I used the shield and covered assisting Officers who were providing lethal cover on the vehicle. I held this position until the vehicle was cleared and rendered safe. After the scene was secured, I was released from the on scene investigation. No further information at this time.
