1 **BACKGROUND/SOURCE:**

2 I am a Detective with the Riverside Police Department assigned to the Centralized
3 Investigations Bureau Persons Unit. On 07-20-18 at 2030 hours, I was requested to respond to
4 the command post at Heritage Plaza to assist with the investigation of an Officer Involved Shooting
5 (OIS) that occurred on Arlington Ave. west of Streeter Ave., in the City and County of Riverside. I
6 arrived at the command post at 2134 hours. Detective Beler was assigned as the case agent and
7 I was assigned as the co-case agent.

8
9 At approximately 2233 hours, I attended the briefing provided by Sergeant Elliott. At
10 approximately 2255 hours, I participated in the crime scene walk through. On 07-21-18 at 0000
11 hours, partner Detective Beler and I responded to the Magnolia Police Station to interview
12 Detective Paez and Sergeant Mouat of the City of Hemet Police Department. I arrived at the
13 Magnolia Police Station at 0009 hours.

15 **INVESTIGATION:**

16 **Interview of Hemet Police Department Detective Art Paez (ID# 10459)**

17 On 07-21-18 at 0042 hours, partner Detective Beler and I interviewed Detective Paez in
18 Sergeant Lomeli's office. The interview was recorded on my Department issued digital recorder
19 and later downloaded. The following is a summary of that interview.

20
21 Detective Paez said he was currently assigned to the Crime Suppression Unit. Earlier that day
22 he was riding in an unmarked Crown Victoria with Sergeant Mouat in the front passenger seat.
23 They were heading to a residence to conduct follow up on a 246 PC (Shooting at an Inhabited
24 Dwelling) that had occurred on 07-13-18. He had obtained a video of the incident which captured
25 two muzzle flashes, and a license plate of the suspect vehicle was also provided. He also checked
26 the vehicle through the ALPR system and confirmed that the vehicle was a silver Chrysler 200 with
27 a black top.

28
29 Detective Paez said he and Sergeant Mouat drove by the residence which was located in a cul-
30 de-sac in the City of Hemet in the 2000 block of Calle Diablo. Initially the vehicle wasn't there but

1 as they were driving off he saw the suspect vehicle approaching their location. Detective Paez
2 immediately made a U-turn and got behind the suspect vehicle which traveled approximately fifty
3 yards before pulling into a driveway of a residence on the cul-de-sac. The front passenger got out
4 of the vehicle carrying two cases of beer. Detective Paez said at that point they really didn't have
5 probable cause to stop the vehicle, they were just conducting follow up based on the license plate,
6 so they had parked along the sidewalk in front of the residence but they did not block the driveway.
7 Detective Paez thought both occupants were going to get out of the vehicle.
8

9 Detective Paez said the front passenger that was carrying the beer seemed to be in a hurry as
10 he headed towards the front door. The driver never got out of the car and immediately started to
11 back up. As the driver backed up Detective Paez waved at him and said hello and that he needed
12 to talk to him. The driver looked right through him. The driver then backed up at a high rate of
13 speed and immediately took off. They got back in their unit and initiated a vehicle pursuit. The
14 vehicle pursuit continued within the city limits of Hemet. Once they got to the 200 block of North
15 California Ave., Detective Paez clearly saw, through the un-tinted rear window, the suspect's (later
16 identified as Arthur Levario) hand come up. Detective Paez said he couldn't see an actual firearm
17 in the suspect's hand, but when he saw the hand come up it was back and at an angle towards
18 them, and he heard one to two gunshots.
19

20 Detective Paez said he did see some debris come off the suspect vehicle and he wasn't sure if
21 it was the muzzle flash or actual debris, but that taken with the sounds that he heard, he believed
22 Levario was shooting at them. Detective Paez told Sergeant Mouat that the suspect was shooting
23 at them and Sergeant Mouat relayed that information over the radio. Detective Paez said he and
24 Sergeant Mouat un-holstered their guns. At that point they were approaching Florida Ave. which
25 was a pretty busy intersection and neither of them had a clear shot on the suspect. The suspect
26 made a westbound turn onto the 74 highway (which was also Florida Ave.) and the pursuit
27 continued. Detective Paez said he wanted to say that Levario shot at them again while they were
on Florida Ave., but he couldn't say for sure when and where without reviewing his body camera.

1 The suspect got onto the 215 freeway. At that point he had already thrown out several items
2 from his vehicle during the pursuit, but Detective Paez couldn't tell what the items were. The
3 suspect continued northbound on the 215 freeway. The suspect was driving on the shoulder in
4 speeds in excess of 100 mph. As they approached heavy traffic, the suspect drove very quickly
5 onto the shoulder and onto the Van Buren Blvd. off ramp. The suspect exited onto Van Buren
6 Blvd. and Detective Paez heard over Sergeant Mouat's radio that another unit had advised that the
7 suspect had fired additional shots. Detective Paez said he did not see or hear any shots at that
8 time because they were still a little behind but they continued with the pursuit into the City of
9 Riverside.

10
11 At that point they continued with the pursuit down various streets throughout the City of
12 Riverside. Detective Paez said he was the primary unit for most of the pursuit but when they were
13 in Riverside the suspect began to create some distance and eventually Riverside Police
14 Department officers took over the pursuit. Detective Paez said he stayed with the pursuit and
15 trailed it to its termination point. At the termination point of the pursuit he parked on Arlington Ave.
16 and ran up to where the primary officers were and he noticed that it looked like the suspect vehicle
17 and been in a traffic collision. Detective Paez said he did not see or hear the shooting that
18 occurred in Riverside at the termination point.

19
20 Detective Paez said he was still wearing what he was wearing at the time of the pursuit.
21 Detective Paez was wearing blue jeans, a black t-shirt with the Hemet Police Department patch
22 design on the right and left shoulder sleeves, and a black ballistic raid vest with a cloth Hemet
23 Police Department badge and "Police" clearly marked on the vest. Detective Paez said he was
24 driving a black unmarked Crown Victoria with a light bar with a solid facing red light in the inside of
25 the vehicle above the front dash on the ceiling.

26
27 Detective Paez said he had no prior contact with Levario before that day. He did not have a
28 description of the suspect in the 246 PC, only the suspect's vehicle make and model and license
29 plate. Detective Paez said when he initially made contact with Levario (before the pursuit) he had
30 walked all the way up to Levario's door and made eye contact with him through the window. He

1 waved at Levario and told him he needed to talk to him and that was when Levario took off.
2 Detective Paez said Levario clearly saw that Detective Paez was a police officer.
3

4 Detective Paez said he was the primary unit in the pursuit until they reached Van Buren Blvd.
5 and Trautwein Rd. There was a short time, when they exited Van Buren Blvd. that CHP briefly
6 took over the pursuit, but Detective Paez became the primary unit once again until Riverside Police
7 Department took it over. After Riverside Police Department took over the pursuit, he basically just
8 fell back and trailed the pursuit to the termination point. This concluded the interview.
9

10 **Interview of Hemet Police Department Sergeant Mike Mouat (ID# 10159)**

11 On 07-21-18 at 0100 hours, partner Detective Beler and I interviewed Sergeant Mouat in
12 Sergeant Lomeli's office. The interview was recorded on my Department issued digital recorder
13 and later downloaded. The following is a summary of that interview. Sergeant Mouat said he was
14 the supervisor for the Crime Suppression Unit. He and his partner Detective Paez were driving
15 around when Detective Paez spotted a car that he had information was possibly involved in a 246
16 PC that had occurred the previous Friday (07-13-18). They flipped around and followed the car but
17 they didn't have probable cause to stop it. They followed it to a driveway and then got out to do an
18 occupied vehicle check. The passenger got out but the driver had seen them, put the car in
19 reverse, and took off. They ran back to their car and initiated a pursuit. Sergeant Mouat said they
20 were the primary unit and another two person unit was behind them as the secondary unit.
21

22 Sergeant Mouat said when they turned southbound on California Ave. from Devonshire Ave. the
23 suspect started shooting at them. Sergeant Mouat heard the shots and saw the muzzle flash and
24 the glass from the back window coming towards them. He broadcasted that out over the radio.
25 They headed west and then northbound on the 215 freeway. The whole time, the suspect was
26 throwing things out of his car but they couldn't see what it was. The suspect was in and out of
27 traffic on the northbound 215 freeway and reached speeds in excess of 110-120 mph. At some
28 point in time Sergeant Mouat switched to RSO's radio because the Hemet Police Department radio
29 was out of range.

1 The suspect exited the freeway at Van Buren Blvd. Sergeant Mouat saw an RSO Deputy
2 parked on the on ramp. Sergeant Mouat heard someone broadcast over the radio that the suspect
3 was shooting again, but Sergeant Mouat didn't hear the shooting. They continued over the Van
4 Buren Blvd. overpass and a CHP unit got in front of them briefly before pulling over to the side and
5 Sergeant Mouat and Detective Paez became the primary unit again. The pursuit continued
6 throughout the City of Riverside. Sergeant Mouat said when Riverside Police Department
7 switched their radio channel he was no longer able to monitor the pursuit so they fell back but
8 continued to trail the pursuit. When they reached the termination point the shooting had already
9 happened and he did not see it.

10
11 Sergeant Mouat said he was still wearing what he was wearing at the time of the pursuit.
12 Sergeant Mouat was wearing blue jeans, a black t-shirt with the Hemet Police Department patch
13 design on the right and left shoulder sleeves, and a black ballistic raid vest with a cloth Hemet
14 Police Department badge and "Police" clearly marked on the vest. He said he and his partner
15 were in a black unmarked Crown Victoria with take down lights. He said when the suspect saw
16 them earlier he could clearly see that they were police officers. Sergeant Mouat said he got a
17 good look at the driver and he was the same person that was in the photo that he had showed us
18 out at the scene (which was a photo of Levario).

19
20 I clarified with Sergeant Mouat if he saw the gun when the suspect initially shot at them. He
21 said he didn't see the gun but he heard it. He said it was loud (because they were close) but he
22 wasn't sure if was a muzzle flash or glass particles that he saw coming out the back of the
23 suspect's car. I asked him if he could see if the suspect was pointing the gun at them. He said
24 based on where he saw the muzzle flash or glass particles, the suspect had to have been pointing
25 the gun over the driver's seat and back to the right, because e everything was in the lower right
26 corner of the rear window. Sergeant Mouat said they were offset a little bit. He said he later
27 looked at their unit and he didn't notice any bullet holes or strike marks. He heard the suspect fire
two to three shots. This concluded the interview.
