On 07-20-18, at approximately 2200 hours, I responded to Arlington Avenue and Streeter Avenue regarding an Officer Involved Shooting that occurred. I was assigned to inspect and chart the weapons of the officer involved in the shooting and the witness officers.

The charting took place at the Magnolia Station. Evidence Technician Meyer assisted with the charting. Meyer also photographed all officers in the uniforms they were wearing at time of the incident. The following officer's weapons were charted. Only Officer O'Farrell's rifle was retained as evidence. All other officer's weapons were returned to them.

OFFICER JARED O'FARRELL (ID 1749)

Officer O'Farrell was the only officer who fired his weapon during this incident. He fired at the suspect using his Colt M-4 rifle. His rifle was charted, along with his handgun.
