62. Narrative of Supplemental Report

I responded to a radio broadcast of Hemet PD involved in a vehicle pursuit that was coming into the city limits with shots being fired at police. I listened to the radio traffic and helped with traffic control at Van Buren Blvd. and Mockingbird Canyon Rd. as the pursuit passed through the city. I responded towards the intersection of Arlington Ave. and Streeter Ave. as the vehicle pursuit continued through the city at a high rate of speed and with the suspect driving on the wrong side of the road at several locations. I was attempting block traffic at this location for the safety of the public and the officers involved when the pursuit abruptly ended just East of that intersection. Shots had been fired at this location and I stepped off my police motorcycle to get out of the line of fire and to assist citizens that were now hiding behind vehicles. I ended up maintaining a perimeter post in the parking lot of Sears on the North side of the scene. I maintained this position until I was directed to the South side of Arlington Ave. where Det. Corbet stated that I conduct an interview with one of the witnesses. I used my BWC and recorded my contact with W-1 [REDACTED]

traveling E/B on Arlington Ave. in the # 2 lane. She told me that she heard and saw a bunch of police cars passing them in the same direction and then saw them coming towards her too. W-1 [REDACTED] told me that she saw a silver car with a black top coming towards them in the # 1 lane. She said she noticed the driver of the vehicle and described him possibly Hispanic and she remembers seeing a white shirt and that he might have had a mustache. W-1 [REDACTED] explained that all the events she remembered all happened in at the same time and she estimated that everything occurred within a matter of seconds. She looked at the driver and told her to pull over to the side of the road. She said two officers ran up in front of their vehicle and blocked them in to where they had nowhere to go. She then heard what she thought were several gunshots. She told me that the gunshots she heard appeared to be coming from the suspect vehicle and that they were towards the officers. She then heard approximately 3 more gunshots that came from the police. She then heard police yelling "Put your hands up!".

W-1 [REDACTED] said she was terrified and was trying to sink down as far in the passenger seat as she could. She thought the suspect was going to get out of his car and trying to get into their car and carjack them. She told her friend to get down and lock the doors. W-1 [REDACTED] told me that 2 or 3 officers ran up to their vehicle and with their guns out and pointed them over the hood as they knelt down behind the engine. She then heard 2 to 3 more gun shots and police yelling "Don't move!". She said then she noticed about 6 officers at the front of her vehicle. She kept telling the driver to duck down and that her friend was leaning over and laying down in her lap. W-1 [REDACTED] also heard police yelling "Get out!" and realized that it was directed at her and her friend. She said she opened the passenger side door and ran out of the vehicle and headed towards the Del Taco. They both ran inside Del Taco and tried to duck down under the windows. She peered out the windows and all she saw was police officers all over the place. She told me that she seriously thought she was going to die. She waited inside the Del Taco until other police officers approached her and asked her to wait around so a detective could talk to her.

Once I was finished speaking with W-1 [REDACTED] I confirmed with investigating detectives that she could return home and then allowed her leave. I maintained a perimeter position until I was properly relieved the next day.
