Narrative:

On 07-20-18, I was assigned as a Detective for the City of Riverside Police Department. I was contacted at 2022 hours by Sgt. Mike Crawford reference an Officer Involved Shooting that occurred in the area of Arlington Avenue and Streeter Avenue in the City of Riverside. I responded to assist and arrived at about 2150 hours. I observed uniformed Riverside Police Department personnel stationed on the perimeter.

I listened to a briefing given by Sgt. Pete Elliott of the incident. I learned a pursuit was initiated by an outside agency during which gunshots were fired at Law Enforcement personnel. The pursuit entered the City of Riverside and Riverside Police Department Personnel became involved in the pursuit. The speed for much of the pursuit varied from around 60 to over 100 miles per hour. At the end of the pursuit, the suspect was driving against traffic westbound in the eastbound lanes of Arlington Avenue east of Streeter Avenue. An Officer involved shooting occurred as the suspect appeared to be exiting his vehicle into traffic. The suspect was pronounced deceased by Riverside Fire Department Personnel at about 2059 hours.

I learned there were several other locations where the suspect was believed to have fired from his vehicle including at Van Buren Boulevard and the 215 Freeway and at Van Buren Boulevard and Barton Street near a fruit stand.

Det. Karla Beler was assigned as the Case Agent and Det. Adrian Tillett was assigned as the Co-Case Agent. I assisted with interviews.

Interview with W/ [REDACTED] and W/ [REDACTED]:

At about 1056 hours, I spoke to W/ [REDACTED] and W/ [REDACTED] together. W/ [REDACTED] is the grandmother of W/ [REDACTED]. W/ [REDACTED] is 12 years-old. W/ [REDACTED] indicated she wanted W/ [REDACTED] to stay with her during the interview. They agreed to speak to me about what they saw.

We spoke inside of Del Taco which is next to where the incident occurred. I recorded the interview on my department issued audio recorder. Officer R. Barajas assisted with the interview by video and audio recording with his body camera.

W/ [REDACTED] said she was driving east bound on Arlington Avenue and they see police lights. They could see a male in a black sports utility vehicle hanging out of the driver's door of his vehicle looking towards the activity. W/ [REDACTED] said the male looked very "pensive" and was like a statue. His vehicle was stopped next to them in an eastbound lane.

W/ [REDACTED] sees Police vehicles coming. W/ [REDACTED] indicated the vehicles were approaching from the east. W/ [REDACTED] said the vehicles around them started turning towards the curb. She said a vehicle began to drive down the middle of the lanes (the opposite way of traffic). She describes the car as gray. She could tell something was wrong. W/ [REDACTED] heard gunshots. The (suspect's) vehicle reached her (W/ [REDACTED]) vehicle. W/ [REDACTED] and W/ [REDACTED] got down. After wards, police came and got them from their car.

W/ [REDACTED] didn't hear any gunshots when she first saw the front of the suspect' car. I drew a sketch based on what W/ [REDACTED] described to me. W/ [REDACTED] indicated she first saw the suspect's car about three car lengths away. She heard gunshots when the suspect's car was about one to two car length away. W/ [REDACTED] said she heard about 3 or 4 gunshots during this time. She did not see the suspect's car hit any of the vehicles. She believed the suspect was traveling at about 20 miles per hour. The suspect's car stopped at least one time during the incident.



W/ [REDACTED] believed there may have been 1 or 2 more gunshots after the suspect's car passed her but she wasn't certain.



The above picture is the rough sketch I drew from W/ [REDACTED] description while I spoke to her. The vehicle on the bottom labeled "W-1" is W/ [REDACTED] vehicle. The suspect's vehicle is depicted as the rectangle to the right of W/ [REDACTED] vehicle and shows the approximate stopping location of the suspect's vehicle. The path of the suspect's vehicle is illustrated by the line between the cars. The circle is the approximate location W/ [REDACTED] first saw the suspect's vehicle. The two "X" marks indicate the approximate area where the first 3 to 4 gunshots were heard.

W/ [REDACTED] said she saw movement in the front of the suspect's vehicle but couldn't tell if it was one or two people inside. She said about 2 to 2.5 minutes elapsed from the time she first saw the vehicle until when the vehicle was behind her.

W/ [REDACTED] did not see an Officer fire a gun. W/ [REDACTED] said there was about 30 seconds from the first 3 or 4 shots heard and the second, possible 1 or 2 shots. W/ [REDACTED] said she was scared. W/ [REDACTED] wanted to let him (the suspect) through and stay in her vehicle because she could hear gunshots and she wanted some protection.

W/ [REDACTED] said everyone was stopped when the vehicles in front of them started to pull to the side.

W/ [REDACTED] and W/ [REDACTED] looked outside the window of Del Taco and pointed out where they thought there vehicle was. W/ [REDACTED] vehicle is a dark gray Volkswagen Jetta. The vehicle they pointed out was on Arlington Avenue near the Del Taco. W/ [REDACTED] said her vehicle was registered to her.

W/ [REDACTED] had no idea if her vehicle was damaged.

I then spoke to W/ [REDACTED]. W/ [REDACTED] said she saw vehicles moving out of the way of the (suspect's) vehicle. She said a male in the suspect's vehicle stuck his arm out and started shooting. W/ [REDACTED] saw his arm but not the suspect. She described the gun as black gun. W/ [REDACTED] was not sure she knew the difference between a semi-automatic handgun and a revolver. W/ [REDACTED] believed it was likely a semi-automatic handgun after W/ [REDACTED] and I described the difference between the two types of guns.

W/ [REDACTED] demonstrated that the suspect reached out of the window, pointed the gun behind him and fired backwards from his vehicle. W/ [REDACTED] said he shot about three times, "Towards the cops." W/ [REDACTED] saw smoke in the air and could smell it. The suspect got closer to their car. W/ [REDACTED] said she ducked down. The suspect drove a little further and was surrounded by the police.

W/ [REDACTED] saw the suspect's gun around the time the suspect's vehicle was about 1 to 2 car lengths away. She believed it was the suspect's left hand out of the window with the gun shooting towards the cops. W/ [REDACTED] said the suspect was very close to them when he may have shot one additional time. She saw cops running towards the suspect's vehicle. Police Officers helped them from the vehicle and removed them from the area.

W/ [REDACTED] was in the rear seat of the vehicle on the right side. I indicated this by drawing a circle in the approximate location of her seat. W/ [REDACTED] was the driver and only other occupant in their vehicle.

W/ [REDACTED] said the suspect may have had a bald head but she wasn't sure. She said the suspect had a hairy arm.

W/ [REDACTED] then said she saw "fast" movement when the suspect was inside of the vehicle.

W/ [REDACTED] and W/ [REDACTED] said they got an impression the suspect had a "tan" complexion.

W/ [REDACTED] said the police created a human barricade between them and the suspect.

I told W/ [REDACTED] and W/ [REDACTED] that I appreciated their help.

I concluded the interview.

I later booked the sketch into evidence.
