10 **NARRATIVE**

12 On 07/20/18, at approximately 2030 hours, I was notified by Sergeant Crawford of an officer
13 involved shooting that occurred at Arlington Ave. / Streeter Ave. He requested I respond to the
14 command post located in the Hardman Center (5100-5200 block of Arlington Ave.) to assist with
15 the investigation. I arrived at the command post at approximately 2130 hours. After the initial
16 briefing, given by Sergeant Elliott, I was assigned to interview witnesses.
17

18 I obtained a statement from [REDACTED] –
19 struck by the suspect vehicle). He told me the following in summary:
20

21 **[REDACTED] STATEMENT (audio recorded via PUMA digital recorder)**

22
23 [REDACTED] stated he had picked up diapers and was on his way home. He was eastbound on
24 Arlington Ave, but stopped at a red traffic signal at Arlington Ave., / Streeter Ave. He observed a
25 lot of police cars travel from California Ave. onto eastbound Arlington Ave. Based on the amount
26 of police cars, he knew it was something "big". He thought a nearby bank had been robbed.

28 [REDACTED] stated his light turned green, and the intersection was clear, so he crossed the
29 intersection and continued eastbound on Arlington Ave. [REDACTED] stated the driver of the Camry
30 braked suddenly, and the Civic bumped into it. [REDACTED] slowed to see what was going on. He

1 observed a vehicle travel westbound Arlington Ave. in eastbound lanes of traffic. [REDACTED] realized
2 it was "a chase", and the suspect vehicle was headed toward him. [REDACTED] tried to get out of the
3 suspect's way.

4
5 [REDACTED] could see the suspect's face. The suspect looked confused and scared, like he didn't
6 know where to go, and the suspect's vehicle slowed.

7
8 [REDACTED] observed a black and white SUV patrol vehicle travel eastbound on the "shortcut road"
9 from California Ave. He observed a muzzle flash from the patrol unit, while the patrol vehicle was
10 still in motion. [REDACTED] did not see the gun, nor did he see if the driver, or a possible passenger,
11 fired the weapon. [REDACTED] ducked under his dash, and heard additional gun shots. In total, he
12 heard three to four gun shots.

13
14 [REDACTED] knew he had to get out of his vehicle. He couldn't exit his from his driver door, as the
15 suspect vehicle was right next to him. He exited his vehicle from the passenger side and crawled
16 to safety. Officers yelled for everyone to get down and get out of the way. Their guns were drawn
17 and pointed toward his vehicle.

18
19 [REDACTED] stated he never saw if the suspect had a gun. However, the suspect vehicle's windows
20 were shattered prior to [REDACTED] hearing/seeing the first gun shot.

21
22 Nothing further.
