4 **Details:**

5 On 07/20/18, at approximately 1946 hours, I responded to assist Hemet Police Officers and  
6 Riverside Sheriff's deputies who were involved in a vehicle pursuit where the driver of the  
7 suspect vehicle, S1, was shooting at pursuing officers. I responded code 3 (lights and siren)  
8 westbound on the 91 freeway and exited Van Buren Blvd so that I could position myself to  
9 assist. I was unable to get involved in the pursuit due to the amount of police units already in the  
10 pursuit. The pursuit traversed throughout the city streets and ended up terminating at the  
11 intersection of Streeter Avenue and Arlington Avenue.

12  
13 I heard the broadcast of "shots fired" and they needed units to block traffic at various locations. I  
14 was then tasked with blocking traffic at the intersection of Madison Avenue and Arlington  
15 Avenue. I walked up to the command post to assist with anything needed. I then located multiple  
16 eye-witnesses who were in their vehicle at the time of the shooting. I kept those witnesses  
17 secluded from the crime scene so that they can be interviewed. I spoke to one of the witnesses,  
18 W/ [REDACTED], who stated to me the following:

20 W/ [REDACTED] was driving in her vehicle and was stopped at the intersection of Arlington Avenue and  
21 Streeter Avenue. W/ [REDACTED] was in the number 2 eastbound lane and waiting for the green light.  
22 Once the light turned green, W/ [REDACTED] drove eastbound in the number 2 lane. W/ [REDACTED] saw a  
23 long line of police vehicles driving eastbound Arlington Avenue with their lights and siren on.  
24 W/ [REDACTED] saw a break in the line of police vehicles and then saw several more police vehicle  
25 travelling from eastbound California Avenue to eastbound Arlington Avenue.

26  
27 Once the last police vehicle drove through, W/ [REDACTED] saw a grey vehicle driving westbound in  
28 the eastbound lanes of travel (wrong way), towards her vehicle. W/ [REDACTED] pulled her vehicle to  
29 the right, along the south curb line because she saw the grey vehicle driving right towards her.  
30 The vehicle slightly struck her vehicle and she couldn't open her driver's side door. Suddenly,  
31 W/ [REDACTED] heard gunshots coming from an unknown location. I asked W/ [REDACTED] if she saw anyone  
32 shooting and she told me no she only heard approximately 3-4 gun shots. W/ [REDACTED] couldn't  
33 determine if the suspect or the officer was shooting.

34  
35 W/ [REDACTED] told me she and her friend, who was interview by another officer, were physically  
36 pulled out of her vehicle by an officer. W/ [REDACTED] then told me she was told to run into the Del  
37 Taco that was just south from where he vehicle came to rest. I asked W/ [REDACTED] if she could  
38 remember anything else from the incident and she told me no.
