NARRATIVE:

On 07-20-18 at approximately 1946 hours, Air One advised the Riverside Sheriff Departments Deputies were in pursuit of a 2012, silver convertible Chrysler (CA. #7JPW282). Air One advised the suspect fired multiple rounds at the pursuing deputies, during the pursuit. The suspect exited the northbound 215 freeway onto Van Buren Blvd. The suspect drove westbound on Van Buren Blvd. into the City of Riverside, Ca. As the pursuit reached Van Buren Blvd. and Barton Rd. the pursuing deputies advised the suspect fired at their vehicles again. RSO requested assistance from the Riverside Police Department. RPD Officers located the vehicle driving westbound on Van Buren Blvd. and advised they were in pursuit. The vehicle traversed through the City of Riverside at a high rate of speed and without any regard for public safety.

As the pursuit continued, the pursuing officers advised the suspect was driving westbound on Arlington Ave. towards Streeter Ave. in the eastbound lanes. At the time of the broadcast, I was driving eastbound on California Ave. towards Arlington Ave. As I approached the intersection, Air One advised the suspect was blocked by on coming traffic and was ramming vehicles. As I reached Arlington Ave. I heard shots fired broadcasted over the radio. I continued onto California Ave. at the split and blocked eastbound traffic with my unit.

I exited my vehicle and grabbed my ballistic shield. I approached the scene and observed the METRO Team had established an arrest team behind the suspect vehicle. I observed several civilians hiding behind their vehicles along the south curb line of Arlington Ave., and ordered them to run towards Melrose St. I reached the METRO Team and gave the officers the ballistic shield. I then met with METRO Sgt. Dehdashtian and offered my assistance. Sgt. Dehdashtian briefed me on the situation, and asked me to assign an officer to pick up the armored rescue vehicle (ARV). I assigned Officer Hoyos to pick up the ARV. Once the ARV was on scene, I assigned Officers Hoyos, Watkins and Maier to relieve the METRO Team while they developed their tactical plan.

The METRO Team approached the suspect vehicle and determined the suspect was no longer a threat to the officers on scene. Once the scene was safe, medical aid was summoned.

After the incident I spoke with Lieutenant Warren (Watch Commander) who released me from the scene.
