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62. Narrative of Supplemental Report

On 7/20/18, I was called out to Arlington Ave. and Streeter Ave., regarding an officer involved shooting, involving Riverside Police Department Officers (See initial call for further details). Upon arriving I checked in with Officer Croker who included me in the crime scene log. Sgt. Elliott provided me with a short brief of what had transpired and introduced me to Hemet PD Sgt. M. Mouat who gave me a short brief of their involvement in the incident. The following is a synopsis of his brief:

Sgt. M. Mouat and his partner, Det. A. Paez, were conducting follow-up on a 246 PC suspect from a prior day when they came upon the suspect vehicle (S1), in the city of Hemet. They tried to conduct an investigative stop when S1 fled and led them on a vehicle pursuit. S1 briefly stopped at a residence where the front passenger was seen exiting. S1 then continued fleeing and at about 200 N. California Dr., S1 fired two shots from a firearm at Sgt. Mouat and Det. Paez.

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S1 continued northbound SR-215 and exited Van Buren Blvd., when they heard an outside agency (Unknown if it was CHP or RSO) broadcast that additional shots were being fired at pursuing vehicles. S1 continued onto northbound Van Buren where he believes additional shots were fired in the area of Van Buren Blvd. and Barton Rd., near Gless Ranch [REDACTED]. Shortly from there, Riverside Police officers joined in on the pursuit until it ultimately came to an end at Arlington Ave. and Streeter Ave.

Based on the additional crime scenes, I contacted Sgt. Simons and requested he and assisting officers attempt to locate evidence near Gless Ranch. See Sgt. Simmons supplemental for further details.

I was notified that the Riverside Sherriff's Department had the Van Buren / SR-215 exit crime scene secured and that they would process it.

Sgt. Mouat advised they had Hemet PD units at 200 N. California and that they were continuing their investigation and would process that crime scene.

After the formal briefing with command staff and investigators, I was delegated with the crime scene oversight at Arlington Ave. and Streeter Ave. I assisted Det. K. Corbett and Senior Forensic Specialist Selena McKay-Davis by searching for the rounds fired by Ofc. O'Farrell. With the assistance of Sgt. J. Munoz and Officers Lin S. Espinosa we canvased the areas of the bullet trajectories and were unable to find strike marks, projectiles or fragments. NFI.
