PC 187 Attempt of a Peace Officer

1 **Narrative:**

2 On Friday, July, 20, 2018, my partner Officer Lin and I were on routine patrol in The City and County of Riverside,  
3 State of California. At about 1950 hours, we were dispatched to assist with an in progress vehicle pursuit in the  
4 eastern part of the city. Radio traffic dictated that the pursuit was headed in the direction of Central Riverside.  
5 Officer Lin and I began to drive in that direction.

7 We arrived to the area of Arlington Avenue and Streeter Avenue and observed that assisting officers were  
8 conducting a High Risk Felony Vehicle Stop on the suspect vehicle. Officer Lin and I immediately began to assist  
9 with traffic control at the intersection of Arlington Avenue and Streeter Avenue with west bound traffic. I positioned  
10 my patrol vehicle and activated my overhead lights and parked it as to divert traffic to a southbound direction. After I  
11 positioned our patrol vehicle, Officer Lin and I began to canvas the area and look for shell casings and any form of  
12 evidence we could locate but were met with negative results.

14 Officer Lin and I remained on traffic control until we were asked to assist with setting a perimeter around the  
15 incident using "Police Crime Scene/ Yellow Tape." We remained at the scene until we were relieved of our duties  
16 by assisting officers at 0810 hours on Saturday, July 21, 2018.

18 The entire incident was recorded using my department issued Body-Worn Video System. The footage was  
19 downloaded and is ready for review.
