62. Narrative of Supplemental Report

On 07-20-18, at approximately 1946 hours, Dispatchers from the Riverside Police Department Dispatch Center broadcast information via two-way radio informing City of Riverside patrol officers of an active Riverside County Sheriff's Department vehicle pursuit on the 215 freeway approaching the City of Riverside; as the information was being broadcast, the pursued vehicle exited the 215 freeway onto Van Buren Boulevard, just outside of the city limits (92518).

The radio broadcast provided the suspect vehicle description of a Chrysler convertible with one suspect occupant driver and officer safety information as the suspect driver was intermittently shooting at pursuing Police Officers and Police Officer vehicle's. Updates with the pursuit location were provided by Riverside Police Dispatch and the Riverside Police Air Support Helicopter as the suspect vehicle continued to travel west on Van Buren Boulevard into the City of Riverside's Orangecrest Neighborhood (92508).

As Officers from the Riverside Police Department and several surrounding agencies continued to pursue the said vehicle throughout the City of Riverside I monitored the radio transmissions while assigned to the Galleria at Tyler ().

As the suspect vehicle approached the area of Harrison Street and Indiana Avenue, approximately .5 miles away from the Galleria at Tyler, I activated my forward facing red light while simultaneously activating my siren and placed my marked Riverside Police Unit at the intersection of Tyler Street and Indiana Avenue anticipating the suspect vehicle to travel toward the Tyler Street and Indiana Avenue intersection.

Several seconds later information was broadcast that the suspect vehicle began traveling east, away from the Tyler Street and Indiana Avenue intersection; while still activating my forward facing red light and siren I drove north on Tyler Street toward Magnolia Avenue. I continued east on Magnolia Avenue to the north mall entrance and with my forward red facing light still activated I parked my police unit on the shoulder of Magnolia Avenue facing east, west of Hughes Alley, anticipating the suspect vehicle to travel toward the Galleria at Tyler.

While I was monitoring the radio transmissions it was broadcast the vehicle pursuit terminated at Arlington Avenue and Streeter Avenue in the City of Riverside, I deactivated my vehicle lights and resumed my assignment at the Galleria at Tyler.
