I booked the above listed evidence into a Perris Station evidence locker on 07/26/2018.

DETAILS:

On Friday, July 20, 2018, about 1935 hours, I was working uniformed patrol as a K9 handler, in a marked black and white K9 patrol vehicle, when I heard dispatch conduct a general broadcast saying, Hemet Police Department was in pursuit of shooting suspect. A few moments later, I heard dispatch broadcast that officers with the Hemet Police Department (HPD) were being shot at by the suspect (later identified as Arthur Levario) in the pursuit.

Dispatch advised they were in the area of Highway 74 x California Avenue, driving westbound toward the city of Perris. I activated my overhead red and blue lights and began driving toward the pursuit. I saw two pursuing HPD officers and the suspect vehicle (Silver Chrysler sedan) drive westbound on Highway 74, past 3rd Street at a high rate of speed. As the suspect vehicle passed, I heard multiple gun shots; however, I was unable to see the gun and unsure if he was shooting at myself or the HPD officers.

I turned around and I notified dispatch I was in the pursuit and notified dispatch the suspect was shooting a firearm. Levario was driving at speeds of 90-100 MPH and failed to stop for the stale red light at the intersection of Highway 74 x Trumble Road. As we approached the northbound on-ramp to the 215 Freeway, I saw Sgt. Morovich at the intersection of Highway 74 and the northbound 215 Freeway on-ramp. As we entered the northbound 215 Freeway, I heard Sgt. Morovich advise over the radio Levario had shot at him (Refer to Sgt. Morovich's report for additional details.)

I was 3rd in the pursuit behind the two pursuing HPD officers and was advising dispatch of the speeds and direction. The pursuit continued on the northbound 215 Freeway at speeds ranging from 80-110 MPH. Levario showed no regard for citizens on the roadway, weaving in and out of traffic and drove on both the east and west shoulders.

As we approached the Van Buren Boulevard exit, Levario exited at a high rate of speed. Deputy Thomas was on the off-ramp waiting to intercept the vehicle. As we made our way through the off-ramp, I heard Deputy Thomas advise over the radio Levario had fired multiple shots, (Refer to Deputy Thomas's report for more detailed information.)

While driving westbound on Van Buren Boulevard, Levario lost control of the vehicle and veered into oncoming (eastbound) traffic, barely missing an oncoming vehicle. Levario then veered back into westbound lanes. The vehicle appeared as if it stalled in the westbound lanes with the vehicle facing northbound across the number one and two lanes.

1 The vehicle started again and continued fleeing westbound on Van Buren Boulevard. While driving
2 westbound on Van Buren Boulevard, Levario failed to stop for several red lights and weaved his way in
3 and out of traffic, almost colliding with several civilian vehicles. At the intersection of Van Buren
4 Boulevard and Washington Street, Levario drove into oncoming (eastbound) traffic. In the area of Van
5 Buren Boulevard x King Avenue, Riverside Police (RPD) officers took over the pursuit as it entered the
6 city of Riverside. I stayed in the pursuit until RPD had a K9 officer join the pursuit. I was not at the
7 termination point of the pursuit and took no further actions in the incident.

9 I responded to the area of Van Buren Boulevard x 215 Freeway to assist Deputy Thomas locate evidence of
10 the shooting. I checked Sgt. Morovich's, Deputy Thomas's, and my vehicle for damage as a result of the
11 shooting. None of the vehicles sustained any damage. I documented the vehicles with my Body Worn
12 Camera (BWC.) While at the scene, Deputy Cook searched the immediate area and located bullet
13 fragments in the street (Refer to Deputy Cook's report for more detailed information.) I had no further part
14 in the investigation.
