3 On Friday, July 20, 2018, I was assigned as the Perris Station Special Enforcement Team
4 supervisor. I was wearing a Sheriff uniform and operating a silver unmarked "stealth" patrol
5 vehicle. About 1935 hours, K9 Deputy James Ray 4680 advised Hemet PD was in pursuit of a
6 vehicle heading into our jurisdiction. Further, the suspect had shot an unknown firearm at the
7 pursuing officers. Deputy Ray and I responded "Code 3" toward HWY 74 in Menifee.

8
9 About 1942 hours, Deputy Ray observed the Hemet PD officers pursuing a Chrysler Convertible
10 westbound on HWY 74 near 3rd Street. Deputy Ray advised he was behind the two Hemet PD
11 patrol units and believed they were being shot at by the suspect. I pulled my patrol car in front
12 of an eastbound HWY 74 traffic and shut it down near the intersection to the northbound 215
13 lanes. As the Chrysler Convertible passed Trumble Road westbound, I heard 2-3 gunshots and
14 saw the driver pointing what appeared to be a handgun in my direction. I was not struck, nor
15 was my car or any vehicle parked immediately behind me.

16
17 The suspect entered the northbound 215 Freeway, and I approved Deputy Ray to join the pursuit
18 as K9 support. I requested Dispatch to patch with Hemet PD, but they were unsuccessful.
19 Deputy Ray used his radio to provide direction and speeds of the Hemet PD pursuit. I followed
20 Deputy Ray and requested Dispatch to contact CHP and Riverside PD to notify them of the
21 circumstances, speeds, and direction of the pursuit. I continued to follow to be in position to
22 assume the pursuit from Hemet PD if we could successfully communicate with them.

23
24 The suspect exited Van Buren Boulevard. Deputy David Thomas 1674 was parked at the off-
25 ramp and advised via radio the suspect was firing a handgun at deputies. The suspect continued
26 westbound on Van Buren Boulevard at a high rate of speed. I directed Deputy Thomas to join
27 the pursuit in case we needed his black and white patrol car for a traffic break. The suspect
28 vehicle temporarily lost control near the former entrance to the Ben Clark Training Center;
29 however, it recovered and continued westbound on Van Buren Boulevard.

31 Riverside PD Airship advised they were overhead of the pursuit. I requested they ensure
32 Riverside PD units were aware of the circumstances and advise when they could take over the
33 positions from Riverside Sheriff personnel. Riverside PD joined in the pursuit on Van Buren
34 Boulevard west of Washington Avenue. Hemet PD unit did not yield and maintained the primary
35 position. Deputy Thomas and I dropped out of the pursuit. Deputy Ray continued for several
36 minutes later until the pursuit entered the city of Riverside.

38 I directed patrol and SET deputies to create a crime scene on HWY 74 between 3rd Street and the
39 northbound off-ramp, as well as at the Van Buren Boulevard off-ramp of the northbound 215
40 freeway. I contacted Lieutenant Lawler and Detective Sergeant Gary LeClair and notified them
41 of the situation. I drove to the Van Buren Boulevard crime scene and remained there until
42 relieved by Sergeant LeClair. I then returned to the station and ended my shift.

44 **CASE STATUS:** EXCEPTIONAL
