25 **S1's Description:**

26 Black male adult, approximately 33 years old, 5'10 ft. tall, 185 lbs., black hair and brown eyes last seen  
27 wearing black/gray shirt and black pants

28  
29 **Narrative:**

30 On 7-22-18, I was working uniformed patrol, driving a marked Riverside Police unit in the City and  
31 County of Riverside. At approximately 1244 hours, I was dispatched to McDonald's, 2242 University  
32 Ave., Riverside CA 92507 reference a battery that just occurred. The subject, later identified as S1, was  
33 being restrained until police arrived.

34  
35 Assisting Ofc. Cuevas arrived first on scene and detained S1 pending further investigation. (See Attached)  
36 Before I arrived on scene, I heard Ofc. Cuevas requested for medical aid over the radio due to S1 being  
37 unresponsive.

38  
39 Upon my arrival, I walked in to McDonald's front counter area where I located Ofc. Cuevas and S1 in  
40 custody. S1 was handcuffed to the rear and leaning on his left side in the recovery position pending  
41 AMR's arrival.

42  
43 I began my investigation and speaking to the involved parties, the following is a summary of V1/ [REDACTED]

1 **V1 [REDACTED] Statement:**

2 V1 [REDACTED] told me he was sitting down in the McDonald's dining room eating with his wife. While he  
3 was eating he noticed S1 sitting across the dining room acting "crazy" as if he was on drugs. V1 [REDACTED]  
4 was speaking on his cellphone when he noticed S1 quickly stand up and walk towards the dining room  
5 entry/exit door facing north towards University Ave. S1 was walking with both of his fist clinched down  
6 to his sides appeared to be angry talking to himself. V1 [REDACTED] noticed S1 began walking towards him  
7 with his fists still clinched down to his sides. S1 was challenging V1 [REDACTED] to a fight, "You want some  
8 of this"! standing over him while V1 [REDACTED] was sitting down. V1 [REDACTED] leaned back to get away from  
9 S1 and told him to get away. S1 angrily began "Spartan kicking" using his whole foot against  
10 V1 [REDACTED] legs. V1 [REDACTED] was afraid of S1 attacking him or his wife therefore he used his foot to  
11 push against S1 to keep him away. S1 eventually walked away from V1 [REDACTED] heading towards the  
12 front counter of McDonald's.

13  
14 V1 [REDACTED] continued eating his food and noticed his food order was made wrong. He stood up and  
15 walked to the front counter. While at the front counter he noticed S1 was swinging his arms throwing  
16 punches attempting to assault McDonald's employees. Employees were running towards the back kitchen  
17 attempting to get away from S1 to prevent being attacked. V1 [REDACTED] saw V1 [REDACTED] the security  
18 guard, attempt to stop S1, but even he could not stop S1. S1 was continuing to throw punches at  
19 V2 [REDACTED] using both of his arms to protect himself and creating distance while walking backwards  
20 away from S1.

21  
22 V1 [REDACTED] told me he realized the employees and V2 [REDACTED] were not able to stop S1, therefore he  
23 stepped in to protect them. V1 [REDACTED] practices Jiu-Jitsu therefore he came under S1's shoulders took the  
24 back mount position. He wrapped his left arm around S1's neck and was starting to apply the Carotid to  
25 "put him out" and stop the threat. V1 [REDACTED] used his body weight and sat down on the ground bringing  
26 S1 down with him. He wrapped both of his legs around S1's lower body and laid on his back. V1 [REDACTED]  
27 applied the Carotid and extended his body flattening S1. V1 [REDACTED] counted out loud, "1, 2, 3, 4, 5" and  
28 put S1 "out". He was able to successfully stop S1 from attacking the employees, security guard, and him.

29  
30 V1 [REDACTED] told me when he felt S1's whole body weight on him, he let go of the Carotid hold and only  
31 held him down. V3 [REDACTED] assisted by holding S1's legs down until police arrived. V1 [REDACTED] noticed  
32 S1 waking up and tensing up his body attempting to get up. V1 [REDACTED] immediately advised him if he  
33 attempts to get up he will apply the Carotid again until police arrived. S1 was upset and began grunting,  
34 but complied until Ofc. Cuevas arrived on scene and detained him pending further investigation. (See  
35 Supplemental Report)

36  
37 V1 [REDACTED] did not have any visible injuries or complain of pain. He denied medical aid and told me he  
38 does not desire prosecution against S1 for kicking him.

39  
40 V1 [REDACTED] told me he did want to hurt S1 and only attempted to stop him from hurting others.

41  
42 I contacted McDonald's security guard, V2 [REDACTED] the following is a summary of his statement.

1 V2/ [REDACTED] Statement:

2 V2/ [REDACTED] works as the security guard for McDonald's. He told me he is familiar with S1, he was just  
3 there last week walking inside the restaurant acting crazy with knives in both of his hands.

4 V2/ [REDACTED] was inside the dining room when he saw S1 walking to the front counter acting crazy. While  
5 S1 was walking to the front counter, he was throwing punches as if he was attempting to fight someone.  
6 The employees were walking backwards trying to get away, and V2/ [REDACTED] got involved by attempting  
7 to stop S1. V2/ [REDACTED] was scared of S1 because he did not know if he had weapons or not and believed  
8 he "was on drugs." V2/ [REDACTED] was unable to stop S1 and was walking backwards to prevent being  
9 assaulted by him.

10  
11 V2/ [REDACTED] saw V1/ [REDACTED] come from behind and apply the carotid "putting him down." He heard  
12 V1/ [REDACTED] count, "1, 2, 3, 4, 5" and saw S1 lose consciousness. V2/ [REDACTED] immediately jumped in  
13 helping V1/ [REDACTED] and held S1's legs down by sitting on them. He used his hands to hold S1's hands  
14 down to prevent him from throwing punches and possibly hurting anyone else. V1/ [REDACTED] and  
15 V2/ [REDACTED] held S1 down until police arrived.

16  
17 V2/ [REDACTED] stated he was not struck by S1 during the incident, but feared S1 would hurt somebody else.  
18 V2/ [REDACTED] does not desire prosecution against S1.

19  
20 I then spoke to V3/ [REDACTED], an employee from McDonald's the following is a summary of her statement.

21  
22  
23 V3/ [REDACTED] Statement:

24 V3/ [REDACTED] is an employee manager for McDonald's. She told me while she was behind the front counter  
25 she heard and noticed there was an incident in the dining room involving V1/ [REDACTED] and S1.

26  
27 V3/Brenda saw S1 acting crazy as if he, "was on drugs." S1 had both of his fists clinched in front of him  
28 in a fighting stance and was throwing punches while walking towards the front counter. V3/ [REDACTED] feared  
29 for her safety and other because S1 was just there last week walking around with knives in both of his  
30 hands. V3/ [REDACTED] walked backwards slowly to get away from S1 and create a distance while police were  
31 being called. While V3/ [REDACTED] was walking backwards, S1 successfully punched her one time. S1 used  
32 his right hand with a clinched fist to punch V3/ [REDACTED] on her left shoulder. V3/ [REDACTED] feared for her life  
33 and safety. When S1 threw the punch, she turned her body sideways to prevent being hit on the face. After  
34 being struck V1/ [REDACTED] stepped in and was able to detain S1 by applying a carotid restraint. V3/ [REDACTED]  
35 told me V1/ [REDACTED] counted out loud, "1, 2, 3, 4, 5" while applying the carotid restraint on S1 who  
36 quickly fell unconscious.

37  
38 V3/ [REDACTED] did not complain of pain nor had any visible injuries. She declined medical on scene. Initially  
39 she desired prosecution against S1, but later changed her mind and decided not to sign a private person  
40 arrest form.

41  
42 Investigative Actions:

43 RFD and AMR arrived on scene that provided immediate medical aid to S1. S1 was transported to RCH  
44 to receive medical treatment, as he was unresponsive.
