5 **Narrative:**

6 On Sunday, July 22, 2018 at approximately 1244 hours, I responded to the McDonald's located at 2242
7 University Ave. in the city and county of Riverside for a report of a subject inside the business trying to fight
8 both patrons and employees. While driving to the call, dispatch put out an update stating the subject had
9 now been restrained. I arrived at approximately 1251 hours. As I walked into the business, I was directed
0 behind the front counter and found V/ [REDACTED] S/Russell, and V/Murray all on the ground to the left of the
1 counter. V/ [REDACTED] was on his back on the ground with S/Russell on top of his facing up. V/ [REDACTED] had his legs
2 loosely wrapped around S/Russell's waist, his left arm was holding S/Russell's left arm out to the side and his
3 right arm was lying straight across S/Russell's chest. V/ [REDACTED] was using his body weight to hold down
4 S/Russell's legs.

5 Based on the call text stating S/Russell was trying to fight both patron and employees prior to my arrival I
6 decided I was going to place him in handcuff while he was under control and not being violent. As I grabbed
7 S's right arm to roll him both V/ [REDACTED] and V/ [REDACTED] let go of him and stood up. I placed S/Russell in the
8 prone position for handcuffing and placed him in handcuffs. Immediately after placing him in handcuffs I
9 rolled him into the recovery position on his left side and began trying to get him to wake up. I used painful
0 stimuli on his sternum, his right trapezius muscle and on the back of his right ear to try and get him to wake
1 up and talk to me. When I would rub his sternum with my knuckles, S/Russell grimaced and clenched his
2 teeth but did not respond to me asking him to wake up.

3 After approximately 30 seconds of trying to get S/Russell to respond I asked dispatch to send medical aid for
4 an unresponsive subject. I asked V/Garcia to stay close by so we could speak to him later. At this time, both
5 Sgt. Medici and Officer Gutierrez arrived to assist. I asked Officer Gutierrez to go get V/ [REDACTED] statement
6 while Sgt. Medici and I waited for medical aid to arrive.

7 I continued to try to get S/Russell to respond to me with no avail. I could clearly see he was breathing by the
8 rise and fall of both his chest and stomach and he was holding his head parallel to the ground. If he was truly
9 unconscious his head would have dropped to his left toward the floor. RFD personnel arrived on scene at
0 approximately 1257 hours. RFD personnel decided it was best to treat S/Russell outside away from all the
1 busy activity going on around us and asked if we could take him outside. I tried to sit S/Russell up into a
2 seated position to better stand him up but he stiffened up his body and would not bend at the waist. I then
3 turned him over into the prone position so Sgt. Medici and I could carry him out to the front of the business. I

1 grabbed S/Russell by his left arm near the shoulder and Sgt. Medici grabbed him by the right arm near the
2 shoulder. We picked S/Russell up and began to carry him out of the business. As we got to the front of the
3 business we set him down on the sidewalk and again placed him in the recovery position on his right side.
4 AMR personnel brought the gurney out of the ambulance and stopped it approximately three feet from
5 S/Russell. Both RFD and AMR personnel assisted me with picking S/Russell up off of the sidewalk and placing
6 him on the gurney in the supine position. S/Russell was still obviously breathing and did not appear to be in
7 any kind of distress. After getting onto the gurney I waited until AMR personnel placed S/Russell's feet in soft
8 restraints before I took the handcuffs off. As they were doing that I saw the RFD paramedic try to check
9 S/Russell's pupils. When he did this he used his thumb and pointer finger to open S/Russell's eyelids. On an
0 unconscious person this would easily open the eyelids to check pupil reactivity but S/Russell was actively
1 closing his eyes and would not let the paramedic check them. I then took S/Russell out of the handcuffs so his
2 hands could be placed in soft restraints for his ride to the hospital. After S/Russell was placed inside the
3 ambulance I did not have any further contact with him. Because we were unable to positively identify
4 S/Russell on scene I drove to Riverside Community Hospital(RCH) to try and use available police databases to
5 identify him. When I arrived at the hospital AMR had not arrived yet. I asked the charge nurse if they had
6 made their notification that they were coming but she said they had not. I cleared the hospital due to an in
7 progress domestic violence call for service that was broadcast by dispatch. Officer's Klein and Vasquez
8 responded to the hospital at a later time to check the status of S/Russell and to try to get a positive
9 identification. See their supplemental reports for details.
