DETAILS:

On Thursday, March 8, 2018 I was working uniformed patrol as the watch three shift supervisor at the Jurupa Valley Station. At 1736 hours, dispatched advised that officers from the Riverside Police Department who were doing surveillance at the residence, located at 9931 Willowbrook, had just been involved in a shooting. Dispatched further stated the suspect was down at the location, however, the residence was unsecure. I authorized all the Jurupa Valley City units to respond code three (lights and sirens) to the location.

I responded and arrived at 1742 hours, as the residence was being cleared by responding officers. Once I received notification that the scene was secure, I advised dispatch to have medical aid, which was staging nearby, respond to the residence. A perimeter was established by crime scene tape and once RPD's watch commander arrived on scene, I informed him I would need a public safety statement from his involved officers. RPD Sergeant McCoy spoke with his officers and supplied me with the information I needed to ensure public safety. I was informed there were two officers who fired their weapons and approximately 10 rounds had been discharged by the two officers in total.

I instructed responding deputies to check the three residences located to the rear of the primary residence to ensure there were no other victims or evidence located at those residences. Furthermore, I contacted Jurupa Valley Detective Sergeant Torrenti and informed him of the incident. Sergeant Torrenti made the necessary notifications to Jurupa Valley Administration along with the Central Homicide Unit.

I stayed on scene as the supervisor and completed the briefing for responding investigators and administration until I was relieved at 2149 hours. This report will be forwarded to the Central Homicide Unit.
