DETAILS:

21 On Thursday, March 8, 2018, I assisted Central Homicide Unit (CHU) Inv. Johnson with an Officer Involved
22 Shooting incident that occurred at 9931 Willowbrook Rd., Jurupa Valley, CA. My assignment was to manage
23 the charting of the Riverside Police Department officers involved with the shooting. This report reflects the
24 charting of RPD Officer Evan Wright.
25

26 The charting of Officer Wright took place in the Community Room within the lobby of the Jurupa Valley
27 Sheriff's Station. Present for the charting were Riverside Peace Officers' Association attorney Saku Ethir,
28 Esq. and Riverside County Sheriff's Forensic Technician Jane Muschell. Forensic Services was present for
29 the charting and photographed process.
30

31 The charting process started at 10:19PM. Forensic Technician Muschell photographed Officer Wright's
32 clothing to memorialize the condition of his uniform at the time of the shooting. He wore (from head to toe)
33 a black t-shirt under a black load bearing (LBV) vest with various pouches sown onto it. The vest had a cloth
34 RPD badge sown on the left chest, a black name tape with WRIGHT and a name tape that read POLICE sown
35 onto the right chest. Below that was a badge that read RIVERSIDE POLICE SWAT TEAM with a Mission
36 bell and Raincross insignia. The back of the LBV had a display patch that read POLICE adhered to it, and
37 above that was a black nametape with WRIGHT sown onto it. Officer Wright wore a black nylon uniform
38 belt with a dump pouch, two pair of handcuff cases, and a thigh holster with one leg strap. He wore green
39 BDU pants and black boots.
40

41 At the time of the charting, Officer Wright's uniform belt was photographed on a sheet of butcher paper. The
42 belt contained (from right to left) a triple magazine pouch with one steel Mec-Gar 8-round handgun magazine
43 and a one steel Mec-Gar 10-round handgun magazine inserted in it. Two black nylon handcuff cases with a
44 pair of handcuffs in each case. A handgun holster with two thigh straps for a Springfield Armory 1911, .45
45 caliber, semi-automatic pistol (s/n: NM490097), with a mounted Streamlight TLR-1 flashlight.

46
47 The firearm was loaded with one live WINCHESTER 45 AUTO round in the chamber, and loaded with eight
48 live WINCHESTER 45 AUTO rounds in an 8-round Mec-Gar steel handgun magazine. The Mec-Gar 8-round
49 magazine was loaded with eight live WINCHESTER 45 AUTO rounds, and the Mec-Gar 10-round magazine

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3 was loaded with ten live WINCHESTER 45 AUTO rounds. A fourth steel Mec-Gar 10-round magazine was
4 stored in Officer Wright's front pocket. That magazine held three live WINCHESTER 45 AUTO rounds.

5 Officer Wright explained after he fired his handgun, he tactically reloaded his firearm with a fresh magazine
6 and retained the ejected magazine in his pocket. According to Officer Wright, he fills each of his magazines
7 to capacity and loads his handgun with one round in the chamber and loads a 10-round magazine in the firearm.
8 According to Officer Wright, his total bullet count is thirty-seven rounds on his duty belt.

9 Next, Officer Wright's LBU was charted. It was removed and placed on a sheet of white butcher paper. The
10 contents of the vest were exposed and recorded. The vest housed a handheld radio and microphone, a digital
11 recorder (that was not activated during the encounter), a flashlight, a rifle magazine, one steel Mec-Gar
12 handgun magazine in a zipper pouch, and two Mec-Gar steel handgun magazines in the magazine holster
13

14 All three handgun magazines were removed and emptied. The two steel Mec-Gar 8-round magazines from
15 the magazine holster were loaded with eight live WINCHESTER 45 AUTO rounds each. The steel Mec-Gar
16 8-round magazine in the zipper pouch was loaded with seven live WINCHESTER 45 AUTO rounds. Officer
17 Wright explained the zipper pouch magazine is an extra magazine and he thought he loaded it to capacity, and
18 added it is not a regularly accessed magazine when he shoots on the range. He was surprised to learn that
19 magazine was not loaded to capacity.

20
21 In total, Officer Wright carried seven magazines that carried sixty live .45 caliber rounds. The charting process
22 revealed Officer Wright was missing eight rounds, from the firearm/magazine charted on his duty belt.

23
24 The scene processing, conducted by CHU Investigator Joshua Manjarrez, located eleven WINCHESTER .45
25 AUTO casings. It is undetermined which of the casings recovered belonged to Officer Soria or Officer Wright.
26 Based on the charting of the two officers who shot during this incident, twelve rounds were missing. Eleven
27 casings were recovered and both officers admitted to loading their magazines to capacity.

28
29 The charting process ended at 11:02PM. Then, Officer Wright and attorney Saku Ethir left the room. A short
30 time later, they met with Inv. Johnson and an interview was conducted.¹ The charting process continued with
31 the charting of Officer Abel Soria.²

32
33 This is an ongoing investigation and the status is open. A copy of this report was sent to Inv. Johnson and
34 incorporated into the investigative packet.
