### DETAILS:

20  
21  
22 On Thursday, March 8, 2018, I assisted Central Homicide Unit (CHU) Inv. Johnson with an Officer Involved  
23 Shooting incident that occurred at 9931 Willowbrook Rd., Jurupa Valley, CA. My assignment was to manage  
24 the charting of the Riverside Police Department officers involved with the shooting. This report reflects the  
25 charting of RPD Officer Abel Soria.  
26

27 The charting of Officer Soria took place in the Community Room within the lobby of the Jurupa Valley  
28 Sheriff's Station. Present for the charting were Riverside Peace Officers' Association attorney Saku Ethir,  
29 Esq. and Riverside County Sheriff's Forensic Technician Jane Muschell. Forensic Services was present for  
30 the charting and photographed process.  
31

32 The charting process started at 11:02PM. Forensic Technician Muschell photographed Officer Soria's clothing  
33 to memorialize the condition of his uniform at the time of the shooting. He wore (from head to toe) a black t-  
34 shirt under a black load bearing (LBV) vest with various pouches sown onto it. The vest had a cloth RPD  
35 badge sown on the left chest, a black name tape with A. SORIA and a name tape that read POLICE sown onto  
36 the right chest. The back of the LBV had a display patch that read POLICE adhered to it. Officer Soria also  
37 wore a shoulder sling for a Defense Technology Federal Laboratory 40mm projectile launcher. He wore a  
38 black nylon uniform belt with a dump pouch, two pair of handcuff cases, and a thigh holster with two leg  
39 straps. He wore green BDU pants and black boots.  
40

41 At the time of the charting, Officer Soria's uniform belt was photographed on a sheet of butcher paper. The  
42 belt contained (from right to left) a triple magazine pouch with two steel Mec-Gar 8-round handgun magazines  
43 inserted in it. A black nylon dump pouch with one steel Mec-Gar 8-round handgun magazine and two live  
44 40mm rubber bullet rounds for the launcher. Two black nylon handcuff cases with a pair of handcuffs in each  
45 case. A handgun holster with two thigh straps for a Springfield Armory 1911, .45 caliber, semi-automatic  
46 pistol (s/n: NM490108), with a mounted Streamlight TLR-1 flashlight.  
47

48 The firearm was loaded with one live round in the chamber, and loaded with eight live rounds in an 8-round  
49 Mec-Gar steel handgun magazine. Each of the two magazines in the magazine pouch contained eight live

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1 rounds. The magazine in the dump pouch was loaded with four live rounds. Twenty-nine rounds were  
2 accounted for on the duty belt. Each of the rounds had a head stamp that read WINCHESTER 45 AUTO.  
3 Officer Soria explained he fired his handgun, then tactically reloaded his firearm with a fresh magazine and  
4 retained the ejected magazine in the dump pouch. According to Officer Soria, he fills each of his four 8-round  
5 magazines to capacity and carries the firearm with one round in the chamber. Therefore his bullet count should  
6 be thirty-three (33) total rounds.

7  
8 The Defense Technology Federal Laboratories .40mm launcher (s/n: D23170), with an AimPoint red dot optic  
9 mounted to the barrel was charted next. It was loaded with one live .40mm foam round in the chamber. A  
10 three round elastic bullet carrier was wrapped around the stock, but no rounds were in it. The weapon also had  
11 a two-point sling mounted to the weapon.

12  
13 Next, Officer Soria's LBU was charted. It was removed and placed on a sheet of white butcher paper. The  
14 contents of the vest were exposed and recorded. The vest housed a handheld radio and microphone, two  
15 cellular telephones, a flashlight and two Mec-Gar steel handgun magazines. Those magazines were removed  
16 and emptied. One 7-round Mec-Gar magazine carried seven live WINCHESTER 45 AUTO rounds. The 8-  
17 round Mec-Gar steel magazine carried eight WINCHESTER 45 AUTO rounds. Officer Soria explained the  
18 seven round magazine is an older version of the Mec-Gar magazines that were issued with an older model  
19 Springfield Armory 1911 handgun that was returned to the RPD armorer. When the newer model of the  
20 Springfield Armory 1911 handguns were issued, they came with 8-round magazines.

21  
22 In total, Officer Soria carried forty-nine live .45 caliber rounds. The charting process revealed Officer Soria  
23 was missing four rounds.

24 The scene processing, conducted by CHU Investigator Joshua Manjarrez, located eleven WINCHESTER .45  
25 AUTO casings. It is undetermined which of the casings recovered belonged to Officer Soria or Officer Wright.  
26 Based on the charting of the two officers who shot during this incident, twelve rounds were missing. Eleven  
27 casings were recovered and both officers admitted to loading their magazines to capacity.

28  
29 The charting process ended at 11:40PM. Then, Officer Soria and attorney Saku Ethir left the room. A short  
30 time later, they met with Inv. Johnson and an interview was conducted.<sup>1</sup> The charting process continued with  
31 the charting of Officer Jeffery Pap.<sup>2</sup>

32  
33 This is an ongoing investigation and the status is open. A copy of this report was sent to Inv. Johnson and  
34 incorporated into the investigative packet.
